MOUNT HOREB SCHOOL CELEBRATES GOLDEN ANNIVERSARY

It was a sea of vivid red, blue, orange, purple, and green tie dye as students and staff kicked off a yearlong celebration of the 50th anniversary of Mount Horeb School.

"Today is such a significant day," said principal Scott Cook. "Kids in 1965 walked down these halls. Isn't that cool?"

Cook took a photographic journey back in time to show the students what was happening 50 years ago. The Civil Rights Movement. The Beatles. Hillary Clinton in high school. The surface of Mars as seen by the spacecraft, Mariner 4. And, of course, that space-aged animated sitcom, The Jetsons.

"Let's watch some cartoons in school, shall we," Cook quipped.

Several former Mount Horeb teachers joined in the merriment on October 9, as did former principals Joseph Palumbo (1992-2007) and William Kimmick (2007-2014).

"You make the school," Kimmick, now the district's curriculum coordinator, told the enthusiastic K-5 gathering. "As adults, we are fortunate to come to school and work with you. We learn as much from you as you do from us."

"Keep studying. Keep working hard and success will come to you," Palumbo added.

Cook, who succeeded Kimmick as principal in early 2014, also announced that the school's PTO will buy a time capsule for the students.

Fittingly, the festivities ended with a video of Chubby Checkers and his 1960s dance craze, "The Twist," with staff and students alike on their feet and wriggling to the beat before heading back to class.





WARREN TWP PARENTS RECEIVE DISTRICT TECHNOLOGY OVERVIEW

Student use of technology in the Warren Township School District was the topic at two recent presentations for parents.

District Curriculum Coordinator William Kimmick outlined the age-appropriate academic uses for the devices assigned to each grade level, with particular attention paid to the Chromebooks issued to each student in grades 4-8.

“We’re very fortunate to have this level of technology in our district,” said Kimmick.

District technology safeguards also were discussed at the presentations on September 30, as was Digital Citizenship – the idea that all students, particularly those in grades 5-8 who are

allowed to take the Chromebooks home, should be aware of acceptable uses of technology and the internet.

While the district is looking into security filters that would monitor student use on the Chromebook when at home, Kimmick encouraged parents to be vigilant, noting that the safeguards currently in place do not extend beyond the school district’s network.

STEM AND THE NEXT GENERATION SCIENCE STANDARDS AT WARREN SCHOOLS

There's a lot of talk about STEM these days. STEM stands for Science, Technology, Engineering and Math. In recent years, there's also been talk of adding the arts to the equation, making it STEAM. But whether STEM or STEAM, it's an area of education that has great impact on the daily work of students and teachers.

Educators and policymakers alike agree on the need for an increased focus on STEM education. New Jersey is among 14 states, along with the District of Columbia, to have adopted the Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS), with plans to implement the new standards in grades 6-12 for the 2016-17 school year and for grades K-5 the following year.

In preparation for the new standards, the Warren Township School District continues to provide professional development opportunities in STEM and NGSS to its science educators.

In July, the district sent three teachers from Warren Middle School to a weeklong science institute at Raritan Valley Community College. Three additional teachers from the district attended the institute the summer before while others participated in the New Jersey Science Convention last October.

"The NGSS line up very neatly with the Common Core standards already adopted in math and language arts," says Kelly Brown, who teaches 8th grade science and who attended the summer institute. "[The new science standards] focus on student-centered learning, which is the direction we have already taken. There are a few changes that we are in the process of making, like teaching the students to be more evidence-based

in their investigations and communicating results based on their evidence."

The foundation of the NGSS is "A Framework for K-12 Science Education," an evidence-based curriculum that focuses on scientific practice (investigative models and theories used by scientists and engineers); crosscutting concepts (a way of linking the different scientific domains and other academic subject areas); and disciplinary core ideas (broad ideas that relate to student interests and are teachable/learnable across multiple grades).

"Our teachers are breaking down the key NGSS practices and crosscutting concepts and

beginning to think about how best to apply the standards in the classroom," says curriculum supervisor Stacey Hann-Modugno. Hann-Modugno and curriculum coordinator William Kimmick are spearheading implementation of the new standards.

A series of additional training sessions are planned for the school year. Science teachers in grades 6-8 will attend workshops on such topics as planning/carrying out scientific investigations, engineering design and technology, developing and using models, and planning NGSS-aligned lessons.

"We like how the NGSS involve the engineering practices and the cross cutting concepts of language arts and math, preparing our students for jobs that have not yet been created," says Brown.









LOCAL ARTISTS TAKE NOTE: THERE'S A NEW PLACE TO DISPLAY YOUR WORK

In October, Somerset County Library System of New Jersey's Warren Township Library branch, located at 42 Mountain Blvd. in Warren Township, unveiled a new space for local artists to display their work in the library. First up were paintings by chair of exhibitions at the Center for Contemporary Art in Bedminster, Wes Sherman.

Sherman has also been a visiting artist at many universities among them Temple, Rutgers, and Pennsylvania Academy of Fine Arts. In 2011, he
