
GIVING TREE



NEW KENILWORTH HISTORY BOOK RELEASE AND SIGNING SAT., DEC. 12

The new Kenilworth history book titled Kenilworth Memories will be released Saturday morning, Dec. 12 at a formal book signing by the author, Walter E. Boright, Ed. D., at the Kenilworth Veterans Center, 33 S. 21st St. The distribution and signing of books that were advance ordered will be held in the lower level of the VFW Hall between the hours of 10 and 12. A limited number of additional books will be available for purchase.

Robert Jeans, post commander noted, "This book about Kenilworth goes above and beyond of what one might expect to find in a local history book. I am especially pleased about the many pages and numerous photographs that pay tribute to the men and women of Kenilworth who served in the armed forces. There is even information about two soldiers — one from the American Revolution and one from the Civil War — who lived in what is Kenilworth today."

Shirley Boyden Maxwell, president of the Kenilworth Historical Society, commented, "Kenilworth Memories takes the reader back to the late 1700s and brings the person to the present time. There are many stories that have never been published in a local history book before and others that present much new information on topics from Kenilworth's past."

Dr. Boright added, "There are many pictures of Kenilworth residents from years gone by to the present day. They were submitted for inclusion in several family sections of Kenilworth Memories. Readers may find themselves, friends, and family members displayed on some of the book's more than 300 pages."

An additional feature of the book signing will be the presence of Charles Shallcross, president of the Union County Historical Society. He is a direct descendant of the Shallcross family, one of the original families that arrived to settle here before 1900 when Kenilworth was a part of New Orange. He will be available to speak with individuals and small groups about the Shallcrosses and to autograph the Shallcross section of the book."


Dr. Boright concluded, "There has been much talk about the chapter in the book of the time in

1946 when a youthful navy man, John F. Kennedy, came to Kenilworth looking for a young woman he met and had taken out in Florida during the war. Her name, where she lived in Kenilworth, and other details are revealed."



EXPLORE THE EXCITING WORLD OF 3D PRINTING

The future has already arrived in Kenilworth NJ, with the addition of a 3d printer for public use at the Kenilworth Public Library. Thanks to a generous gift from the Ralph W. Errington Fund, visitors to the library can design, download and print 3d objects.

The printer, an Ultimaker 2, works by laying down layers of superheated plastic filament onto a gradually lowering build plate. Layers of plastic are laid down and fused together until a three dimensional object appears. It looks like magic, but in reality science and technology are what really drives this printer.

The printer was the centerpiece of the library's Tech Tuesday program series for teens, held in summer 2015. Along with computers, robotics kits, and microcontroller technology (also made available through donations from the Errington Fund), local children were encouraged to design and print their own projects. Miniature animals, jewelry, and even a working grasping hand have been just a few of these projects. You can even print a bust of yourself, using a repurposed

scanning camera and some free software.

One recent project holds great promise for fiber enthusiasts. A library staff member purchased two extremely sharp wool combs, which can easily damage objects around them or injure a person. Using nothing but our printer, free online software, a ruler, and a calculator, the library staff was able to quickly design and print a plastic cover that protects both the comb, its owner and whatever it's stored with. Problem solved!

Perhaps the most exciting printer-related development is seeing children, some as young as nine years old, design printable 3d objects using a computer. Hopefully, this skill, developed at such an early age, will inspire a generation of architects, engineers, designers, animators, artists, game designers, and other leaders.

Come visit our library and learn what it takes to create and print 3d images. There is no cost to use this service, but some policies, procedures and time constraints may apply. As always, it's an exciting time to visit the library!

TRINITAS DESIGNS PROGRAMS TO SERVE ITS MILITARY VETERAN PATIENTS

Elizabeth, New Jersey The specific medical and mental health needs of veterans are being addressed through a series of programs offered by Trinitas Regional Medical Center.

Thanks to the support of the Thomas Glasser Foundation, Inc., Trinitas participates in a special National Hospital and Palliative Care Organization (NHPCO) and Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) program that offers enhanced patient care and other services to veterans. To address the needs of current veterans and the growing number of veterans in the next 10 to 20 years, the interface with the VA and the NHPCO gives veterans care with the dignity, recognition, and gratitude they deserve.

"The new grant-funded program supports the ongoing measures Trinitas uses each day to meet the health care needs of service men and women while they are under our care," explains Magie Cruz, RN, MSN, Director of Palliative Care. "This program is another way that Trinitas doctors, nurses, and other health care professionals members, as well as our volunteers, respond to the needs of veterans, their families

Johanna Thomas, Intervention Clinician of Hospital Elder Life Program (HELP), at Trinitas works closely with Trinitas staff and volunteers to identify vets when they are admitted for care. of their service to our country."

One of our two

licensed social workers is an active reservist and our Advance Practice Nurse is retired from the Air Force. Their common bond with veterans is so important to the positive patient outcomes we strive for in this program. The Project Pride program provides individual, group, and family psychiatric services designed to reduce symptoms and improve the quality of life for veterans and their families. Ultimately, in partnership with the VA, we direct our energies toward helping veterans live the life they want and deserve."














