

## TRINITAS DESIGNS PROGRAMS TO SERVE ITS MILITARY VETERAN PATIENTS

of veterans are being addressed through a series of programs offered by Trinitas Regional Medical Center in Elizabeth, New Jersey.

Thanks to the support of the Thomas Glasser Foundation, Inc., Trinitas participates in a special Hospital and Palliative Care Organization (NHPCO) and Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) program that offers enhanced patient care and other services to veterans. To address the needs of current veterans and the growing number of veterans in the next 10 to 20 years, the interface with the VA and the NHPCO gives veterans care with the dignity, recognition, and gratitude they deserve.

"The new grant-funded program supports the ongoing measures Trinitas uses each day to meet the health care needs of service men and women while they are under our care," explains Magie Cruz, RN, MSN, Director of Palliative Care. "This program is another way that Trinitas doctors, nurses, and other health professionals members, as well as our volunteers, respond to the needs of veterans, their families and caregivers. It's a natural complement to our existing Palliative Care program and a fitting way to treat our valued veterans who deserve everyone's respect and gratitude."

Johanna Thomas, Intervention Clinician of Hospital Elder Life Program (HELP), at Trinitas works closely with Trinitas staff and volunteers to identify vets when they are admitted for care. "Upon admission to the hospital, we ask patients if they are military veterans and if they'd like

The specific medical and mental health needs information about veterans' benefits. We are also proud to give them a formal acknowledgment

of their service to our country."

The Behavioral Health and Psychiatry Department of Trinitas makes a valuable contribution to the mental health needs of veterans who suffer from a range of mental health issues, including Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD), all of which negatively impact their quality of life. Linda Reynolds, Director of Adult Outpatient Services, explains: "In partnership with the Elizabeth Veterans Administration (VA), Project Pride for Veterans is a counseling and

case management program. One of our two licensed social workers is an active reservist and our Advance Practice Nurse is retired from the Air Force. Their common bond with veterans is so important to the positive patient outcomes we strive for in this program. The Project Pride program provides individual, group, and family psychiatric services designed to reduce symptoms and improve the quality of life for veterans and their families. Ultimately, in partnership with the VA, we direct our energies toward helping veterans live the life they want and deserve."



## THE 1950S - WHEN CARS WERE KING, AND DEALERSHIPS LINED ST. GEORGES AVE

Nothing evokes memories of the 50s like the sleek automobiles coming out of Detroit that embodied the spirit of a new and modern American society where the biggest and the best seemed available to all. It was a time when the major car companies introduced their new models on TV spots featuring the sparkling beauties in lavish, albeit shown on black and white screens, unveiling ceremonies. It was a time when the make and model were easily recognizable by rocket inspired wraparound windshields, or the size and shape of tail fins. It was a time when automobile dealerships lined the major thoroughfares of cities and towns across the country. In Rahway, twelve dealerships, eleven of them on St. Georges Avenue, were in operation ready to help put the latest models in everyone's driveway.

The following is a list of local dealerships and a sample of the advertising come-ons they used in print ads to entice car buyers to visit their showrooms. The ads focused on style, economy and above all else – newness.

Frank Van Syckle's Dodge -Plymouth Agency was opened in 1926 when it was located on the corner of Murray Street. In 1950 the business moved to the property opposite Elm Avenue which had been recently vacated by Amon Buick who had moved into newer, larger quarters near Lake Avenue. Van Syckle's, which was one of the original Dodge-Plymouth dealerships in the United States, was gone by 1959. The building was later used as a dry cleaning establishment until it was razed in 2011. Today, a modern structure houses a Subway sandwich shop and Skaff's Pharmacy on the site.


In 1957 the C. Gordon Miller family took over the Cadillac dealership located on the corner of Milton Avenue that had been operated by the Boland Brothers since 1904. In a 1959 print ad, Miller touted the new Cadillac as "Motordom's new measurement of greatness," and promised, "Satisfaction beyond its cost." Miller was at the Rahway location until the end of 1998 when the business moved to Routes 1&9 in Woodbridge. The Milton Avenue showroom was razed a few years later and is now the site of TD Bank.

Rahway Motors Company, located between Milton Avenue and Maple Avenue, sold Packards and was established at the beginning of the auto boom in 1950. Rahway Motors ran ads introducing their 1955 Clipper as, "The car that makes it smart to be different!" By 1959 they were selling Mercurys and praising "Their space age-planned bodies, advanced design, superior performance, and economy." They were "the cars that show you what new really means." Rahway Motors lasted until the early 1980s. The building still stands and is used for medical offices.

West End Garage was the oldest Chrysler-Plymouth dealer in Union County having been established in 1914. In 1931, Nelson Taylor, owner of the dealership, built a new showroom on the corner of Maple Avenue. In '59, West End publicized the "Lion-Hearted '59 Chrysler...Elegance without equal...the car













that's every inch a new adventure." The Taylor family owned and operated West End for just short of 100 years. Today the building serves as a showroom for DZ Motors.

C.W. Rich & Son opened its doors to the public in 1940. By the '50s the agency was introducing "The all new Galaxy with Thunderbird elegance, Ford size, and savings." Located next to West End Garage, the dealership became Bell Ford in 1957 and remained at the site until the mid-60s when Bell moved to Route 27 in Colonia. The Rahway building continued to serve as a showroom for several dealerships and today is part of the DZ Motors complex.

Alex Amon, who came to Rahway in 1926, had a showroom on Irving Street (1926-1928) and St. Georges Avenue opposite Elm Avenue (1929-1950). In 1950, ground was broken for a new sales and service facility located across from Roosevelt School that would become the home of Amon Buick. From their modern new showroom they would advertise, "The best Buick yet with new sweep-ahead styling and new sizzle to match," and recommend that, "Before you buy a car with a low price name, see why you're better off with a Buick." The facility was razed in the 1990s and is now the site of Walgreens.

South of Inman Avenue, still on St. Georges, were five more dealerships including Martin Kaiser-Frazer, a dealership on the corner of Orchard Street which was in operation from 1950-1959. Today, a Quick Check stands on the

site. On the lot next to Martin's was Metchick Motors on the corner of Plainfield Avenue. Metchick sold DeSoto and Plymouth models from 1947-1953. Today, an empty lot marks the site of the dealership.

Laurie Motors, on the site of what is today the Firehouse Restaurant, sold DeSotos from 1950-1957. They advertised, "It's Here! A great and glorious new beauty – the '56 DeSoto with new V-8 Power...designed for the super highway age with new pushbutton driving and 255 horsepower."

The Hinkle Motors showroom still stands between Murray Street and Colonia Boulevard and today houses the United Auto Service Center. Hinkle sold Oldsmobiles from 1945-1956. "Ohh-h those '56 Oldsmobiles!"

Sun Motors stood on the site of what is today STS Tires from 1958 to the late 1990s. In a 1958 ad they featured the ill-fated Edsel as "An exciting new kind of car...a full six passenger beauty... a car that makes history by making sense."

The lone dealership off the St. Georges Avenue tract was Rahway Auto Supply and Service Company, the oldest Chevrolet dealer in Union County. Founded in 1919 by William Hoblitzell and his three sons, the dealership was located on W. Milton Avenue next to the railroad elevation and served the Rahway area until the early 1990s. Today the remodeled building is the showroom of Liberty Harley Davidson.



## **DOCTORS OPEN OFFICE TO MEET NEEDS IN SURGERY AND PRIMARY CARE**

Dr. Baerga, who is fluent in Spanish and English, is board certified in general surgery while Dr. Vasyl Pidkaminetskiy is board certified in family practice and internal medicine with fluency in Ukranian, Russian, Polish, and English.

Dr. Baerga received his medical degree at Ponce School of Medicine in Puerto Rico. Prior to joining Trinitas, he was associated with Montefiore Medical Center Department of Surgery/Albert Einstein College of Medicine in New York where he performed acute care surgery and was responsible for medical resident training and education. He was a general surgeon at New York Methodist Hospital in Brooklyn, New York and an attending physician at the New York Methodist Emergency Department.


Dr. Pidkaminetskiy completed his medical training Ivano-Frankivisc Regional Hospital in Ukraine where he later was an Assistant

Professor in Anesthesiology-Critical Care. He served his medical residency at Kingsbrook Jewish Medical Center in New York. While associated with Crystal Run Health Care in Upstate New York, he provided internal medicine services in Goshen and Warwick. Prior to joining Trinitas, Dr. Pidkaminetskiy practiced internal medicine in Clifton, Wallington and Passaic, New Jersey, and was affiliated with St. Mary's Hospital in Passaic and St. Joseph's Medical Center in Paterson.




## **LETTERS & GOODY BAGS**

### **HISTORY OF WREATHS**

Wreaths have been a part of human civilization for thousands of years going back as far as the ancient Persian empire. As decoration, wreaths appear on the ceiling tiles of 'Dura Europus', a 2000 year old synagogue in Syria. They were commonly used by Hebrews and Ancient Greeks.

Wreaths first appeared in history as crowns for royalty. Made by twisting branches into a circle and decorating them with flowers, pine cones and colorful ribbons which were worn on their heads. Later crowns evolved into the hat style made of gold and gems which kings and queens still wear during state ceremonies.

In many cultures young maidens would adorn themselves with headdress wreaths decorated with seasonal flowers and worn during festive celebrations until their wedding day. This practice is still popular in many counties around the world.

Pagans made wreaths of evergreen branches with four candles representing the elements of Earth, wind, fire and water which were lit during pagan religious gatherings. This custom was adopted by Christians, the Advent Wreath with three purple candles for penance and one pink for 'the coming joy'. One advent candle is lighted on successive Friday evenings during the four weeks of advent and all are blown out on Christmas eve.

In Rome, wreaths made of laurel leaves were awarded to victors in athletic games, who would then hang them on their wall as a souvenir. Later many rich Romans hung wreaths on their door as a status symbol. This tradition was adopted by early Christians and became the popular Christmas wreaths we now enjoy.

In Christian tradition, the Christmas wreath symbolizes the circle of life and eternal life promised by Jesus Christ as well as God's strength. Today Christmas wreaths are highly decorated with brightly colored ornaments and lights.




