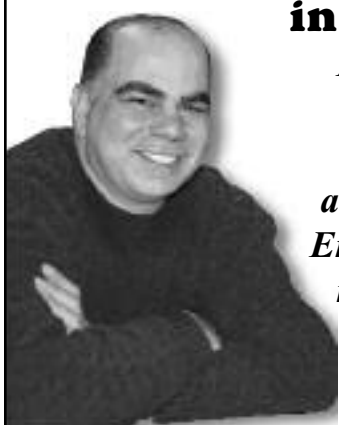

WATCHUNG STUDENTS GO ON VIRTUAL FIELD TRIPS USING GOOGLE EXPEDITION

Technology Leader, Arielle Goldstein, of Watchung Borough school district writes, "Today I went from the depths of the ocean to the Moon. I visited the Galapagos Islands, the Colosseum, Antarctica, Mars, and Mount Rushmore. I saw sharks, pythons, and polar bears all from inside the school."

Ms. Goldstein continues, "Along with students and teachers in grades 2-8, I went on and controlled a number of virtual field trips today thanks to the Google Expedition app. Currently in beta testing, the Watchung Borough school district was lucky enough to have Google Expeditions come to our schools on Wednesday, October 28th to let our students explore."

Using 360 degree views of different places around the world, students used Google Cardboard to explore. Turning left and right, looking up and down, each student could see a panoramic view of oceans, cities, outer space, jungles, and more. There a large number of expeditions to choose from that relate to all areas of curriculum. Teachers control the synchronized images on the students' "Cardboard", and can direct them to a specific point on the image. Students see an arrow directing them where to look, allowing teachers to have their class all looking at the same thing and ready to learn. There is no way to replicate the experience. This technology has brought learning to another level!

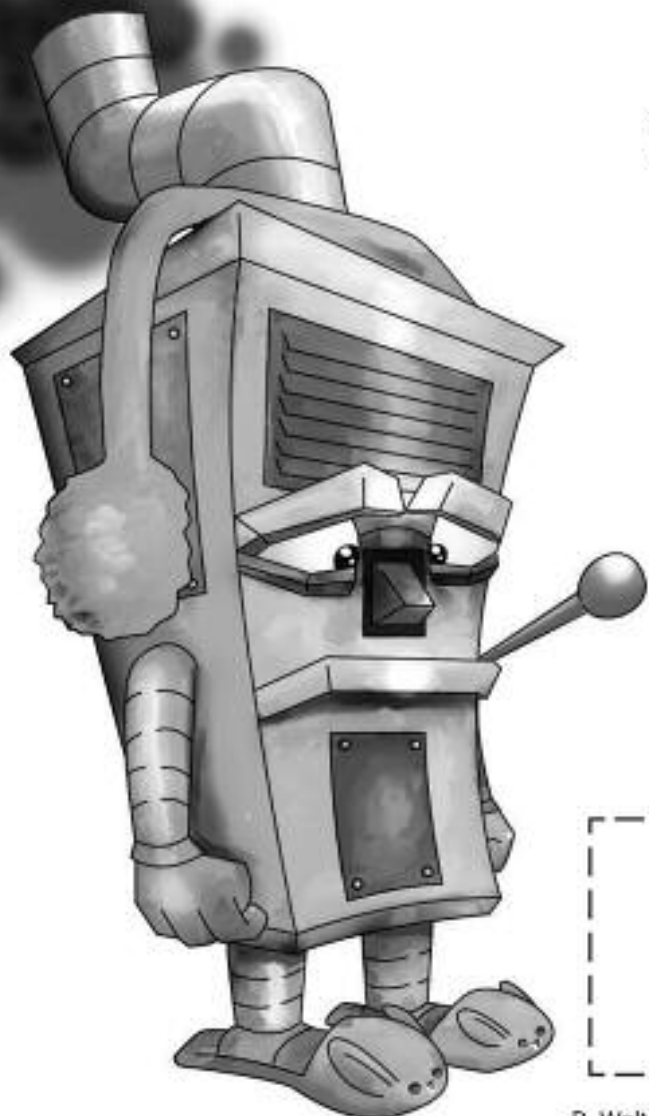
Arthur Murray has locations in Green Brook and Highland Park, New Jersey. The studio hosted the private party for Ms. Williams.

ONE OF AMERICA'S STAR LIBRARIES

Somerset County Library System of New Jersey has been named one of America's Star Libraries in the eighth edition of the Library Journal Index of Public Library Service, sponsored by Baker & Taylor's Bibliostat. This year, of the 261 libraries in the United States that have been designated as America's Star Libraries, six of them are in New Jersey. This is the third year in a row, and sixth time in eight years, that SCLSNJ has been named a Star Library.


"Receiving this recognition once again underscores our library system as an effective, efficient and essential cornerstone community institution," said Brian Auger, SCLSNJ's County Library Administrator. "This truly is a testament to the hard work and dedication of the staff."

The Library Journal Index is a measurement tool that compares U.S. public libraries with their spending peers based on four per capita output measures: circulation, library visits, program attendance, and public Internet computer use. Scores on the Library Journal Index are produced by measuring the relationships between each library's statistics and the averages for its expenditure category.

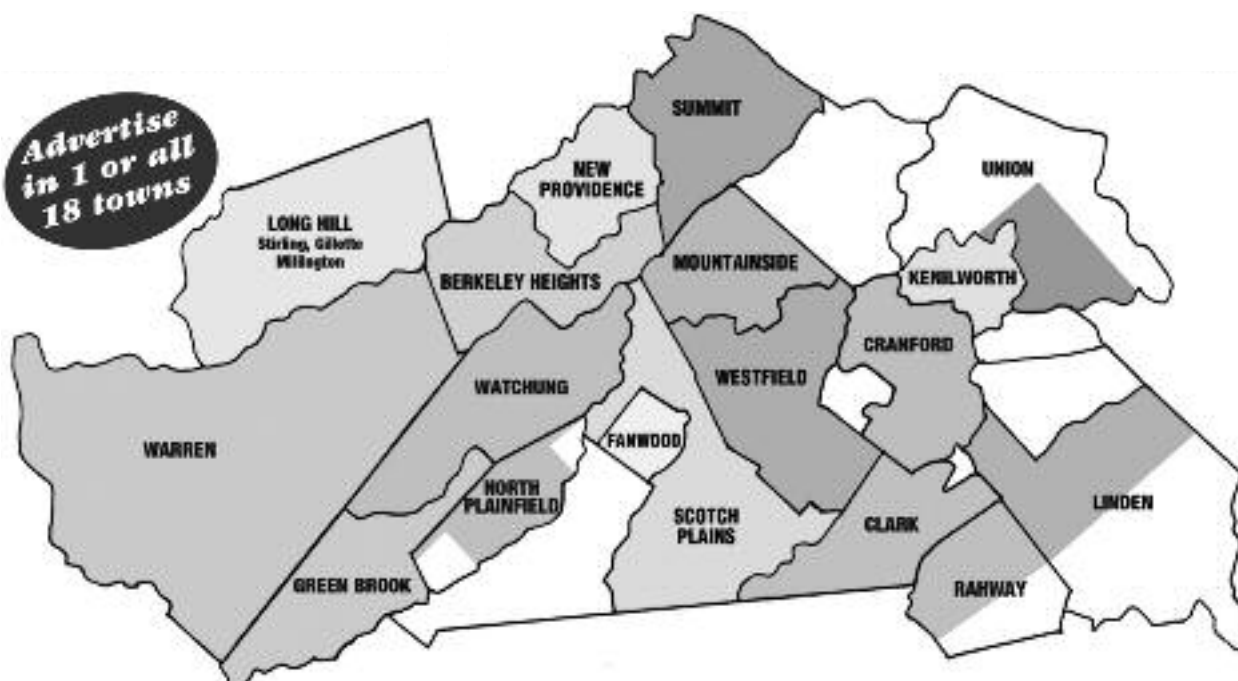

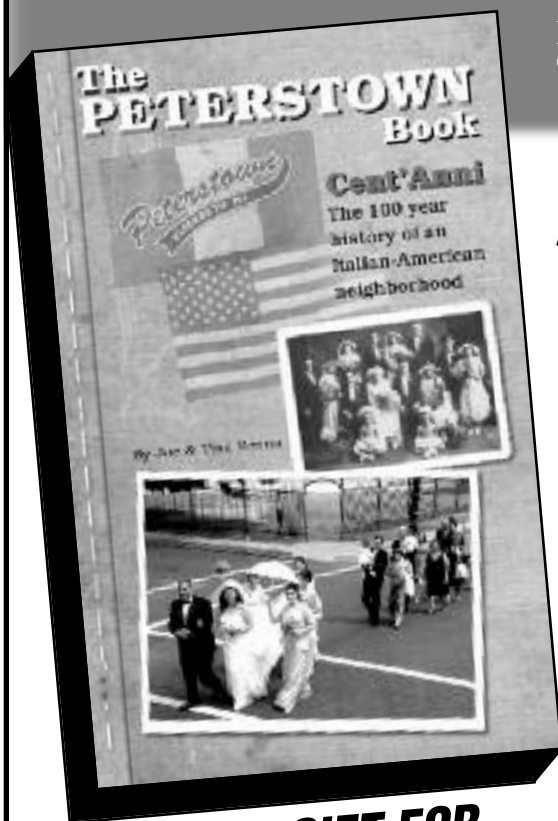
