
CATHOLIC LEAGUE OF FORENSIC "DECLAMATION" COMPETITION





barbershop style; i.e., four-part harmony sung a cappella (without instrumental accompaniment). The chorus is a chapter of Sweet Adelines International, a highly respected worldwide, independent, non-profit organization of women singers committed to advancing the musical art form of barbershop harmony through education, competition and performance. Founded in 1945, Sweet Adelines International is among the world's largest singing organizations for women, boasting nearly 24,000 members. Barbershop music, which developed in the late 19th century, is a style of a cappella singing based on four-part harmony achieved by a lead, tenor, bass and baritone.

The Kenilworth Gospel Chapel is an independent community Bible church with a congregation of approximately 165 adults and children. The chapel was constructed in 1936 by a number of chapel members, including the family of local pioneer James Arthur, who built many homes in the area in the late 19th/early 20th centuries and founded the New Orange Park project.





