The Kenilworth Historical Society is an independent volunteer-based, non-profit, tax-exempt, 501(c)3 organization dedicated to the research, preservation and interpretation of the Oswald J. Nitschke House, local history and culture. The recently restored Nitschke House "living history" museum at 49 South 21 Street features five authentically furnished historic rooms on the first floor for interpreting life in the early 1900s, an exhibition center on the second floor and a cultural arts center on the lower level, all of which are wheelchair accessible.

# NARCAN DOSE KITS USED BY POLICE

Since the inception of the Narcan deployment program on July 1, 2014, the Kenilworth Police Department has embraced the opportunity to use whatever tools are available to help those in need of medical assistance. Patrol officers from our department are equipped with dose kits containing the drug Naloxone which is used to reverse the effects of opioids during an overdose. The dose kits are kept available at all times in every vehicle in the department's patrol fleet. Each officer has gone through the required training to carry and administer the treatment to people in distress due to an opiate induced overdose.

Since January 1, 2016 officers administered the treatment on three separate occasions, all with lifesaving results. Chief John Zimmerman states "He commends the efforts of this community's emergency response personnel involved in these saves" and "Pledges a continued commitment to drug education and awareness starting at the elementary school age of our children in order to help combat this state's opiate addiction epidemic".

The Kenilworth Police Department will continue to work in cooperation with the Union County Prosecutor's Office in order to provide this added service to our community.

This romantic comedy by playwright John Cariani opens the library's annual Bard on the Boulevard series, which will continue through the summer.

On a cold crisp late winter evening, in a charming little town without a zip code, people find love, friendship and unexpected connections in Almost, Maine. A woman carries her heart, broken into nineteen pieces, in a small paper bag. A man pursues a lost love and finds it in an unexpected place. A couple keep the love they have given each other in large red bags, or compress the mass into the size of a diamond. These playful and surreal experiences are commonplace on one deeply cold and magical Midwinter Night, for the humorous and plain-spoken citizens of Almost. The quirky comedy serves up a series of loosely connected tales about

love, each with a compelling couple and a touch of sorcery at its center, making for the perfect early spring play.

The Hudson Shakespeare Company of Jersey City was founded in 1992 and is now in the midst of its 24th season of touring Shakespeare Theater.
