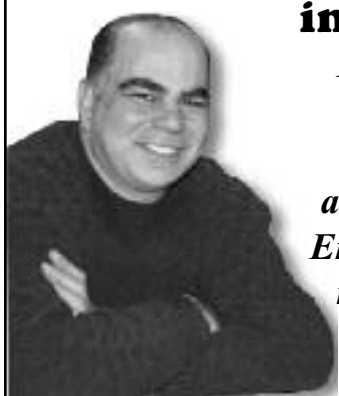

In addition, the students enjoyed a Victorian Tea in which fresh strawberries, tea sandwiches (ham and cheese, turkey and cheese

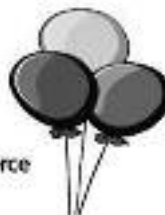

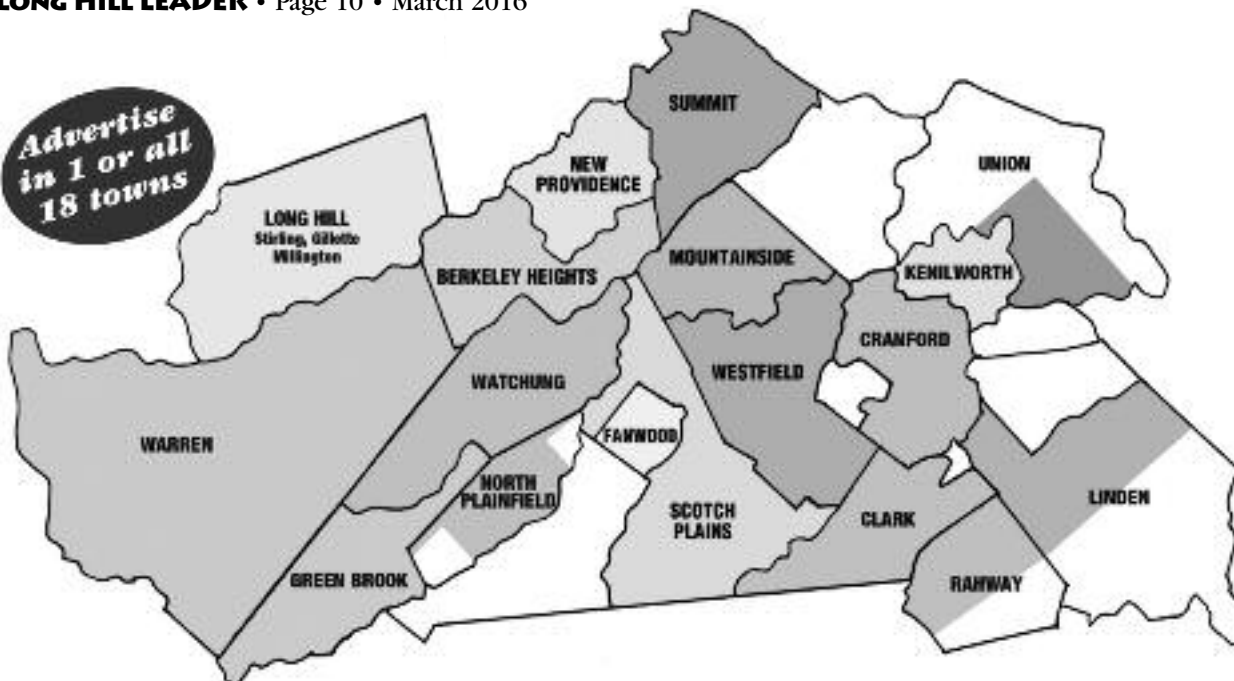

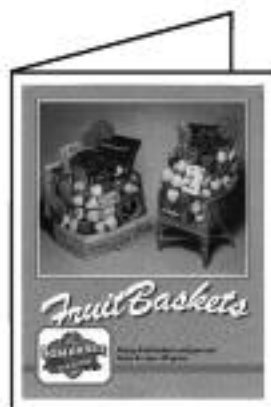
