

FIRE DEPT AND RED CROSS HOME FIRE SAFETY CAMPAIGN

On April 16, 2016 The Linden Fire Department in conjunction with The American Red Cross held a Home Fire Safety Campaign in parts of Linden's 5th and 8th wards. The Red Cross went door to door canvassing these wards informing residents of the free smoke detector install being offered. If the resident needed smoke detectors the Linden Fire Department, with off duty members from Linden's FMBA locals 34 & 234, would follow the Red Cross volunteers doing an evaluation of the home and installing what smoke detectors were necessary to make the home safe. The free detectors were donated through a Red Cross Home Fire Safety Campaign. The Fire death rate in homes with working smoke alarms is 51% less than the rate for a home without this protection. An estimated 890 lives could be saved each year if all homes had working smoke alarms. Properly installed and maintained smoke alarms save lives and protect against injury and loss due to fire. The free detectors being installed are sealed units with a 10 year battery, insuring that the detector is operational for years to come.

This was the 3rd install day held in Linden, the other 2 were in April and August of last year in parts of the 4th, 5th and 8th wards. In addition to the detectors, the Red Cross was passing out home safety information to residents and the Linden Fire Department was informing them of their File of Life Program. A program that gathers resident's pertinent medical information that is kept in their home to help expedite an ambulance call by making the information readily available to EMS workers. If residents were not home, missed the canvassing or are in a different ward and would like free detectors installed in their home, they can call Linden Fire Prevention (908) 474-4560 to set up a date for an install.

The day was a huge success, installing 112 detectors in 54 homes and canvassing 720 homes with fire safety information bringing the total for this campaign to close to 300 detectors installed in over 150 homes with close to 2000 homes canvassed. The day could not have been a success without the many volunteers from the Red Cross, Linden High School's Red Cross and ROTC programs doing the information canvassing and Linden's FMBA Locals 34 & 234 doing the detector installs.

HOOKED ON FISHING NOT ON DRUGS COMES TO LINDEN

"Hooked On Fishing - Not On Drugs" is a unique, nationally recognized program created by the Future Fisherman Foundation. In 2012, Governor Christie signed legislation establishing the statewide implementation of the HOFNOD program. The legislation provided initial funding through an appropriation of \$200,000 from the state's Drug Enforcement and Demand Reduction Fund.

The goal of New Jersey's program is to encourage school-aged children to avoid tobacco, drug and alcohol usage by providing alternative activities that involve learning to fish, appreciating aquatic and environmental resources, and developing positive life skills. The program will provide students with access to extracurricular outlets that utilize New Jersey's incredible outdoor recreational assets.





MEMORIAL DAY 2016

A Veterans Epilogue to all the brave military personnel that have made the supreme Sacrifice.

The question, sometimes politically-loaded, that is often asked of family members and war buddies of our Fallen Heroes.

"Was it worth it?"

Marine Corps General John Kelly recently offered a unique perspective. A veteran of Iraq and Afghanistan himself, General Kelly lost his youngest son, First Lieutenant Robert Kelly, while conducting combat operations in Helmand Province in 2010. General Kelly was asked if the loss was worth it by a reporter with National Public Radio. He said, quote:

"I think what I tell families now is the only person really that has a right to answer that question – was it worth it? – is the young man or woman that lost their life. And I believe what they would say is that they were doing what they wanted to do. They were where they wanted to be. So that's the answer, I think, to that question. It's not for us that survived to answer it. I think it's for those young people to answer. And I think they do answer it with their actions and obviously their lives."

In 2003 Army Private First Class Diego Rincon of Conyers, Georgia, wrote to his mother from Iraq: "Whether I make it or not, it's all part of the plan. It can't be changed, only completed. Mother will be the last word I'll say. Your face will be the last picture that goes through my eyes...I just hope that you're proud of what I'm doing and have faith in my decisions."

PFC Rincon died soon after writing the letter. The American Legion will always be proud of the selfless service of Robert Kelly, Diego Rincon and the more than one million men and women who have made the Supreme Sacrifice for the United States since our nation's founding.

General Kelly is right. 'Was it worth it?' is the wrong question for us to answer. Instead, we should commit ourselves to "Make it Worth It."

We should insist that America remain the land of the free. A land where patriotism trumps politics, where the American Flag is displayed proudly and frequently and where military veterans are society's true celebrities.

We must NEVER forget the families of our fallen. Long after the battlefield guns have been silenced and the bombs stop exploding, the children of our fallen warriors will still be missing a parent. Spouses will be without their life partners. Parents will continue to grieve for their heroic sons and daughters that died way too early.

We need to be there for them, not just as members of The American Legion family – but as American citizens. Nobody can replace these fallen heroes – especially in the eyes of their families – but we can offer shoulders to cry on, assistance with educational expenses and assurances that their loved one's sacrifice will not be forgotten.

While there is nothing unpatriotic about an auto race, a trip to the beach or a barbecue, we should reflect on the true meaning of Memorial Day. Let us remember that tyrannical regimes have been toppled and genocides stopped because Americans sacrificed life and limb. Let us remember that terrorist plots were foiled and

killers brought to justice because Americans were willing to pay a high price. Let us remember that without a U.S. military, the world would be a far more oppressive and darker place. Let us remember that freedom never had a greater friend than the American Soldier, Sailor, Airman, Marine and Coast Guardsman.

The Preamble to the Constitution of The American Legion charges our organization to "Preserve the memories and incidents of our association in the Great Wars."

Lydia Bixby, a Boston widow, was believed to have lost five sons in service to the Union during the Civil War.

President Lincoln's letter to the grieving mother was read on-screen by the actor portraying General George Marshall in the film Saving Private Ryan. The letter reads:

Dear Madam,

I have been shown in the files of the War Department a statement of the Adjutant General of Massachusetts that you are the mother of five sons who have died gloriously on the field of battle. I feel how weak and fruitless must be any word of mine which should attempt to beguile you from the grief of a loss so overwhelming. But I cannot refrain from tendering you the consolation that may be found in the thanks of the republic they died to save. I pray that our Heavenly Father may assuage the anguish of your bereavement, and leave you only the cherished memory of the loved and lost, and the solemn pride that must be yours to have laid so costly a sacrifice upon that altar of freedom.

Yours very sincerely and respectfully, A. Lincoln

So while the "Was-It-Worth-It" question can only truly be answered by those who made the sacrifice, it is up to all of us to make it worth it.






