## EAGLE SCOUTS GIVE BACK TO GOVERNOR LIVINGSTON'S THEATER AND MUSIC PROGRAMS

Peter Illis, a Junior and Andrew Stecher, a Senior at Governor Livingston recently completed their Eagle Scout projects with Troop 368. Peter's Eagle Scout project came from his work in the GL theatre and GLTV. He designed and built shelves and a workbench in the theatre backstage area prop room. He also designed and funded a dedication plaque to the former technical director, Mr. Kenneth Stiefel, a staple member of the high school theater community who unfortunately passed away due to cancer last year.

Herb Horwath, Peter's Eagle Advisor said, "It has been my pleasure to work with Peter. He faced a few challenges during his project, some of which were last minute, and was able to come up with great solutions. I am very impressed by his growth and leadership."

Peter is a member of Stage and TV crew at the Governor Livingston School and has been involved in theatre productions since 6th grade. He has regularly filmed school events, including concerts, assemblies, and football games. He is now working with the Berkeley Heights Township Council to film meetings, and broadcast them on GLTV. He is also working with TAP to produce videos for their YouTube channel.

He volunteers his time to video Board of Education events. In recognition for all his contribution to the community, Peter was recently awarded the Union County's "Unsung Hero" award.

Peter has been involved with scouting since he was a Tiger Scout in Pack 468. His High Adventure trips took him to the Bahamas and Philmont. Peter has worked the last three summers at the Scouting Camp, Sabattis and will return there this year to be on the COPE staff.

Andrew Stecher, baritone player and bagpiper for the Governor Livingston Highlander Marching Band wanted to give back to his school and the band, where he found immense camaraderie and support. In addition to the Marching Band, Andrew plays trombone for the school's Jazz and Concert Band, he also performs with the Concert Choir. Andrew is also a member of the Stage Crew and plays in the pit orchestra for the school's musical productions. Outside of school, Andrew plays bagpipes for the Saint Columille United Gaelic Pipe Band, a competing band dedicated to Gaelic pipe music and culture.

For his Eagle project, Andrew took charge of refurbishing the trophy shelving and 300+ trophies of his award winning school band. His project involved cleaning and fixing all the trophies, then tearing out the old shelves, and then building

and installing new decorative shelves for the trophies. As a result of his project, the trophies in the Governor Livingston Band Room are now organized by year on newly constructed display shelves.

Mr. Nicholas O'Sullivan, Band Director at the Governor Livingston High School said, "For the past 55 years, the Highlander Band is a tradition of performance and excellence that the community of Governor Livingston is most proud of. Andrew Stecher's Eagle Scout Project is something that preserves this legacy for years to come. The new shelves are both sturdier and more visually attractive. Additionally, all of the trophies were dusted off and organized by year and decade. The trophies in the Band Room date back to the sixties all the way to today. I am most pleased with the work Andrew and his team have done and on behalf of the band, the band parents, and the communities Governor Livingston represents, I can say that we are all very grateful."

Andrew has enjoyed the outdoors since he was a Tiger in Cub Scout Pack 368. His Boy Scout High Adventure trips have already included hiking & backpacking at the Philmont Scout Ranch in New Mexico, sailing and snorkeling in the Bahamas, and whitewater rafting in the Gauley Mountains of West Virginia. He is heading to the Grand Canyon this summer and Philmont again next year as an adult scout advisor. Andrew would like to major in Engineering.

Retired and active police officers joined coaches, parents, and community members at the Oak Hill Golf Course, 15 Fernwood Drive in Milford, New Jersey for the Berkeley Heights Police Athletic League (BH P.A.L.) annual golf outing on Monday, May 16th.

Golfers enjoyed lunch before the 12 PM shotgun start. Participants in this year's event had their choice between three different Ray Ban sunglasses styles as well as a cigar bags sponsored by JR Cigars. Dinner and program followed golfing.

The Berkeley Heights P.A.L. has been the primary financial partner, improving Board of Education and Township fields. The annual outing is the prime fundraiser for the organization. Current improvement projects include Hendrick and Upper Columbia softball fields, as well as a partnership with Union County that developed three new baseball fields at the Sansone site.

P.A.L. President Joe Graziano added, "parents and residents are usually surprised to hear that the P.A.L. financially contributes most of the maintenance and improvement on our fields."

"In the last few years, we also have expanded the programs offered and launched a running club, volleyball program, and field hockey clinics. All three were new to the P.A.L.," said Graziano.

The organization has brought on a volunteer field maintenance expert to its Board in 2016. They are also fitting out the Columbia Middle School gymnasium to accommodate more courts, hoping to expand the already successful volleyball program. Upcoming plans include possible improvements to Passaic Field to increase soccer playing time.

"This is our biggest fundraiser of the year and we need our golfers to come out and support this event," concluded Graziano.

MRS. SUSAN POAGE

Grade 1 Teacher,

Mary Kay McMillin Early Childhood Center

Susan Poage started her career in the Berkeley Heights Public Schools in September 2000 as a Substitute Teacher. She was hired as a Classroom/Special Education Teacher Aide at Hamilton Terrace School in March 2001 and then served as a HELP Teacher at the Early Childhood Center during the 2001-2002 school year. Mrs. Poage was first employed as a Kindergarten Teacher at Hamilton Terrace in September 2002, and she taught Kindergartners at the school through the 2013-2014 school year. Susan has been teaching First Grade at the Mary Kay McMillin Early Childhood Center for the past two years.

"Mrs. Poage is a highly-effective teacher who applies content-area knowledge to instructional practices that connect big ideas to meaningful, independent exploration and practice, providing multiple avenues to success," explained Anne Corley-Hand, Principal of Mary Kay McMillin Early Childhood Center. "Upon entering her classroom, however, you might think you had entered K-Mart after a blue-light special, as there will be materials and children taking up all available table and floor space. Her child-centered, project-based classroom is alive with enthusiastic students who are motivated and encouraged to use their talents and gifts to be the best that they can be."

Mrs. Poage earned her Bachelor of Arts Degree in Elementary Education from the State University of New York at Cortland and she received her Master of Arts Degree in Early Childhood Education from Kean University. Well-known for her outstanding ability to teach scientific concepts to the youngest of learners, Susan was presented with a Presidential Award in Mathematics and Science Teaching by the National Science Foundation in 2009. During her career at the Early Childhood Center, Mrs. Poage has served as a member of the Strategic Planning Committee, Science Curriculum Committee, Science Textbook Review Committee, Grammar Committee and Council on Instruction. Susan has also been a workshop presenter and an active participant in the annual Berkeley Heights Education Foundation Basketball Game for many years.

One of her nominators has written that "Mrs. Poage's classroom is one of excited learners

whose individual needs are met through unique and engaging learning centers, as well as many hands-on activities. Children are encouraged to be creative and their learning can be demonstrated in a variety of ways." A colleague added that "Susan has always been a vocal advocate for students who were out of the mainstream in our community. Through classroom lessons, bulletin boards, and parent visitations, she has supported all students who don't fit the norm, championing and supporting various cultural differences."

MRS. ANN BIRD

Speech-Language Specialist

Thomas P. Hughes School

Ann Bird began working in the Berkeley Heights Public Schools as a Supplemental Speech Correctionist during the 1978-1979 school year. She was then hired to her first full-time Speech position, working with students at Thomas P. Hughes and William Woodruff Schools, on September 1, 1979. Since that time Mrs. Bird has worked tirelessly with students in Grades Pre-Kindergarten through 8 throughout our school district, helping them to develop their speech and language skills.

"Ann Bird is the kind of teacher that you wish YOU had as a child," said Jessica Nardi, Principal of Thomas P. Hughes School. "She has the innate ability to connect with kids and not only effectively helps students with their speech and language needs, but she also helps students have an overall positive school experience. Children feel good about themselves when they are with Mrs. Bird, and this helps foster their academic and social growth across their school day.

On a personal note, it always brightens my day when Mrs. Bird brings her students to the office to tell me jokes!"

Ann earned her Bachelor of Arts Degree in Speech from Douglass College of Rutgers, The State University; and she received her Master of Science Degree in Speech Pathology from the Rutgers Graduate School of Education. An active member of numerous Speech-Language and Hearing associations, Mrs. Bird has helped enlighten her fellow staff members as a workshop presenter, has been a member of the district's Wellness Committee, and has served as a cooperating professional for college students completing their internships. Also, during the 1994-1995 school year, Mrs. Bird was chosen as the Teacher of the Year at William Woodruff School.

Her nominators have said that "Mrs. Bird has an excellent rapport with her students and she develops and nurtures a love of learning in them. She develops creative ways to help students accomplish their speech and language goals. While reading books, Mrs. Bird will bring in manipulatives, pictures, or objects to help students understand the language and the context of the story. Ann and her students put forth great effort during these lessons, but the students hardly notice that it is work. Mrs. Bird also communicates effectively with parents and she is always available to teachers and parents to

discuss the progress being made by her students."

MRS. GINA HOLZMANN

Gina Holzmänn has been employed in the Berkeley Heights Public Schools for the past 15 years. She started as a Grade 5 Teacher at Thomas P. Hughes School in September 2001 and moved to Grade 3 at Hughes before becoming Assistant Principal at Columbia Middle School in July 2008. Mrs. Holzmänn served as the CMS Assistant Principal for nearly three years before returning to the classroom and her current position, Third Grade Teacher at Mountain Park School, in September 2011.

"Mrs. Holzmänn combines the use of the creative aspects of teaching that students enjoy with a very structured and thorough approach," said Jon Morisseau, Principal of Mountain Park School. "By employing technology, differentiation, and cooperative learning, she is able to teach the whole child. Her annual efforts to obtain grants which fund special projects and learning opportunities further enrich her students' educational experiences. In addition, Mrs. Holzmänn serves as an integral part of the district's K-5 Language Arts Committee, where her knowledge of writing instruction is an extremely valuable asset."

## DAYS OF REALIZATION

The students of Governor Livingston High School recently participated in the "Days of Realization" program. Every 15 minutes, someone in the United States dies as the result of an alcohol related traffic collision. Due to this startling fact, several TREND students at GLHS organized this two-day program.

On the first day, students were taken from their classrooms and an announcement was made over the loudspeaker announcing their death. Their faces were painted white and they were returned to class; however, they were not allowed to speak for the remainder of the day. After school, the 26 students and three staff members who suffered this fate were taken to an undisclosed location for the night. Here, they participated in activities and heard from a guest speaker, who tragically killed her friend as a result of an alcohol-related accident.

During their time away, students and staff members were asked to write letters to their loved ones, saying what they would not have gotten to say if this were in fact a real situation. The next day, in an assembly program for the junior and senior students, specific members of this group

shared their letters with the student body. In addition, Maria Esteves of the Union County Prosecutor's Office shared the heartbreaking story of losing her 9-year old daughter due to the actions of a drunk driver.

The program was a simulation of the impact that traffic fatalities have on a community of people. We hope that this program will help students realize the true risks of reckless behavior and understand the dangers of driving under the influence.

This program was driven by GLHS students with assistance and guidance provided by Mr. Robert Segear, Berkeley Heights Student Assistance Counselor. Also assisting and providing leadership were School Resource Officers, Officer Edward Gaffney of the Berkeley Heights Police Department and Detective Shaun Bendik of the Mountainside Police Department. The program was completely supported through numerous donations by the generous people and businesses of Berkeley Heights and Mountainside, as well as by the Berkeley Heights and Mountainside Municipal Alliances.

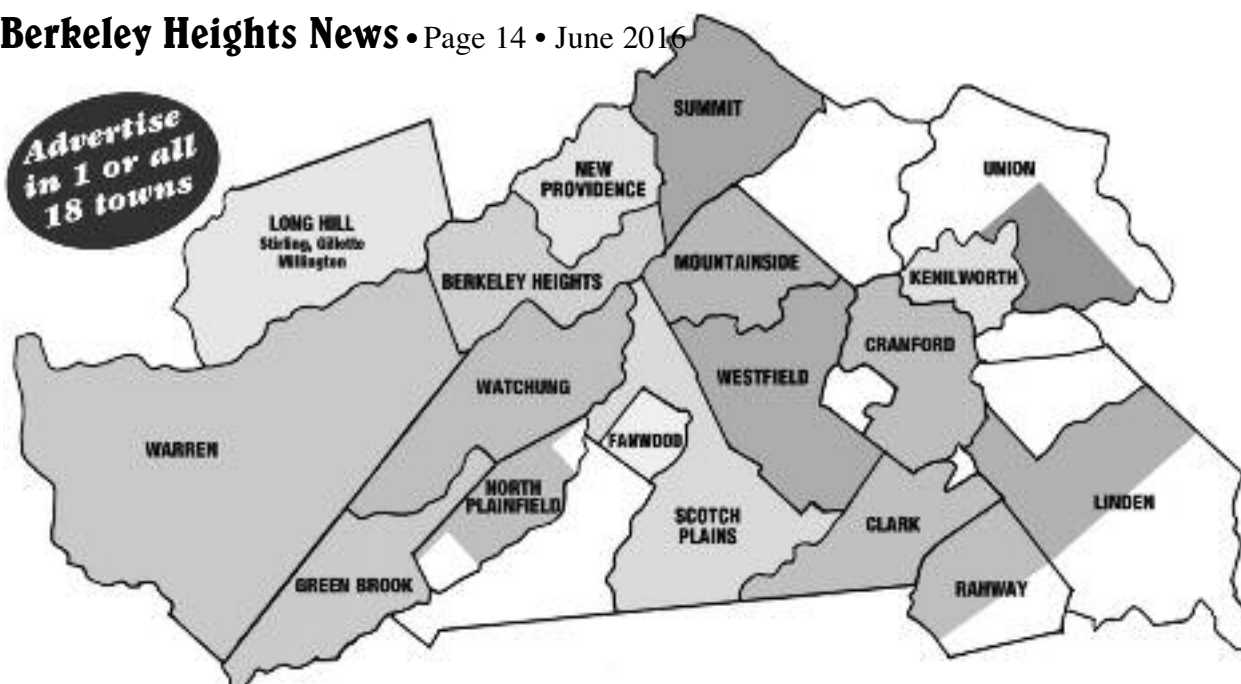

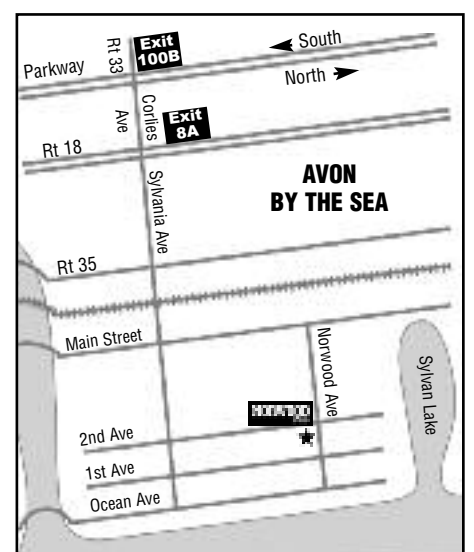
