On Sunday, May 22nd the Borough of Kenilworth and the Pride in Kenilworth Committee relaunched their Annual Kenilworth Street Fair. Held along the Boulevard, this event featured over 100 exhibitors selling new items, arts & crafts, collectibles, novelties and lots of cool items. There was a car show held by the high school that showcased over 75 classic and muscle cars.

Now in its fourth year, this event was dropped in 2015 but was brought back by popular demand to the delight of close to 10,000 fair goers that attended.

The children had a blast in the Kids Travelin Shindig area which had kiddie rides, inflatables, face painters, ice cream, temporary tattoos and a special appearance from Batman, Bat Girl & the Bat Mobile. The parents had a great time taking pictures with these super heroes compliments of JC Promotions, Inc., the event producers.

If you were hungry, there were over 25 food vendors selling everything from sausage and peppers, steak sandwiches, dogs and burgers, gourmet guacamole, empanadas, genuine polish kielbasa & sausage, Italian delicacies, kettle corn, ice cream and much more. If you are a fan of food trucks there were over 10 gourmet food trucks there selling to long line of hungry fair goers.

For the super stars out there, this event had a section to karaoke. Over 35 people got up and sang to their hearts content and had a ball doing it.
