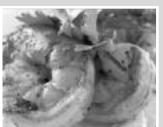


Barbara is currently the New Jersey Association for Health, Physical Education,








ROBERTOZZI NAMED SUPERINTENDENT OF THE YEAR

Linden Superintendent of Schools, Dr. Danny Robertozzi, has been named Superintendent of the Year by NJTESOL (New Jersey Teachers of English as a Second Language) in recognition of the district's pioneering efforts to establish the Seal of Biliteracy in our state.

The Seal of Biliteracy is a special designation that students can earn on their diplomas and transcripts that certifies that the student is proficient in two languages. Thanks to the efforts of Dr. Robertozzi, Linden's department of Bilingual, ESL and World Languages and others who have advocated for this effort, the SEAL has now been recognized and signed into law in New Jersey by Governor Christie.

"In Linden we are eager to continue promoting the SEAL of Biliteracy in our schools," commented Dr. Robertozzi, "I hope that the number of states and districts participating in this program will continue to grow, and with it a culture that values and nurtures the talents and assets that culturally diverse, biliterate students contribute to our community and nation.


June witnessed thirty-one Linden High School seniors graduating with the NJ Seal of Biliteracy on their diplomas. New Jersey has joined more than a dozen other states in recognizing and rewarding students who demonstrate linguistic proficiency in two or more languages. Students applying to the program must pass a rigorous language assessment in order to graduate with the Seal on their diplomas. Qualifying students must demonstrate that they can speak, read, and write in a second language at a high level of proficiency. This distinction serves the purpose of highlighting the students' special abilities to universities and potential employers in the global market place.

Linden Public Schools took a lead role in piloting the program, and was among the first NJ districts to help students to earn the Seal. Since 2014, over 100 Linden students have earned the Seal of Biliteracy.

Alphonsina Paternostro, Linden's supervisor of Bilingual, ESL and World Languages commented; "In our district we place a great value on our linguistic and cultural diversity. We see language learning as a very worthy endeavor, and offer students the opportunity to study a wide variety of world languages. The Seal of Biliteracy is another way to celebrate and highlight important skills that will help to open the doors to new opportunities for our students as they go out into the world."



The Fire Safety campaign started last year is a 5 year program to install free smoke detectors in residents home, this was our 4th install day. To date the program has installed almost 500 detectors in 225 homes and canvased over 2800 homes.

The Linden Fire Department was also able to offer residents free carbon monoxide detectors provided by Kidde Fire Safety along with the free smoke detectors provided by the Red Cross. The carbon monoxide detectors were donated by the Kidde Fire Safety Company after hearing of the tragic loss of a young Linden resident that did not have a working carbon monoxide detector in the home. The Kidde company donated 75 free detectors to the Linden Fire Department and made it possible for us to get more at a discounted rate so we can make sure our residents have a working CO detector in their homes so that this tragedy may never happen again in our community.

If there are any Linden resident in the fourth ward we did not visit or anyone in any ward that would like the fire department to visit to install free smoke detectors, you can call Linden Fire Prevention Bureau at 908-474-4560 and let them know you would like to set up an install.



The Linden Police Department is pleased to announce the creation of a new Internet Exchange Zone. This is a secure location for interested parties to safely complete a transaction that was initiated over the internet. The location is directly in front of Police Headquarters and is monitored by 24 hour video surveillance. In the event of cold or inclement weather, the parties can enter the lobby of Police Headquarters, which is also under 24 hour surveillance.

The idea was suggested by 2nd Ward Councilman Donald Beyer, after hearing of a recent transaction that turned into a robbery. Police arrested an Elizabeth juvenile in that incident. There have been other instances over the past several years where residents have been victimized while negotiating internet transactions, which turned into a crime.

Police Chief Jim Schulhafer said that he hopes the creation of an internet protection zone will help to bring awareness to the possible dangers of these types of transactions and provide a safe and secure environment. The police department is advising residents to try to complete their transactions during daytime hours and bring along a friend if they still feel uncomfortable meeting the other party to a sale.




