### TIMOTHY CHUNG WINS BRONZE IN ARCHERY NATIONALS

Archery is a unique sport that challenges its competitors to have extreme focus and precision when attempting to shoot an arrow. Timothy Chung from Berkeley Heights, 16, has a passion for archery, made evident when he competed in the U.S. National Target Championships, U.S. Open and Easton JOAD Nationals from July 13th through the 17th, taking home the Bronze medal.

This year Alabama had the pleasure of hosting the US Open for adults, and Easton JOAD Nationals for youth, which attracted thousands of archers from around the world, one of them being Timothy Chung. Chung draws his inspiration from his family, who have a heavy military background. His father, YI Chung, would often take his son to the shooting range to shoot rifles and from these trips he began making the connection to archery. Soon after Chung's interest in archery began to grow, he initiated a search for a coach who could help him achieve Olympic style status in the world of archery. He found this with Coach John Nyberg.v

Chung explains that every archer during practice has the ability to accomplish the perfect shot, but the true test of skills is established during competition. With the mental stress that is surrounding the athlete, from the droves of people watching their every move, to one's own insecurities that they might possibly miss their mark, mental preparedness is essential in order to dominate in this sport. Personally, Chung practices every day, although he admits that his competitors have the edge and practice more hours than he



does, but he finds his competitive edge investing time on his mental focus. He found guidance in the book, With Winning in Mind, by Lanny Bassham. Chung uses the technique and information found in this book to give him the kind of cerebral concentration that would allow him to dominate his competition.

This year Chung missed his opportunity to make the Olympics, something he regrets, but isn't discouraged. He still has his eyes set on achieving his dreams of representing his country in the Olympics one day. Chung remains humble and focused stating, "While I am grateful for the success, the medal doesn't change anything: I am still very passionate of the sport."



The ever popular senior citizen bus trip to Atlantic City is still going strong and is more popular than ever, especially in these summer months when people would much rather be outside enjoying the summer weather than indoors. For the past 14 years Ramona Radbmacher, 2nd vice president and Program Chairwoman, has put together this special monthly event to provide community members a chance to enjoy all the attractions that Atlantic City has to offer.

The trip is approximately two hours long, during the ride to Atlantic City patrons are granted first class treatment. The Senior Center has secured Vanderhoof Bus Services, providing brand new plush seating, with plenty of leg room, accommodating up to 56 individual passengers. During the 2 hour ride passengers are entertained by a movie, or may choose to conserve their energy by taking a nap before the fun filled day ahead.

Once the commuters reach their destination, they are free to enjoy the scenery, take their chances at the casino, enjoy the beaches and boardwalk. If the traveler decided to try their luck at the casino, the trip includes a \$25 coupon for slot play. The sightseer could also grab a bite to eat, courtesy of the Senior Center, by way of a \$10 food youcher, also included in the ticket.

The amount of people that have attended the senior citizen trip has remained steady ranging from 35 to 55 people, during the summer months, when it is most popular, people have been turned away because of lack seating space. The winter is when the numbers dwindle, but those cold winter months still produce 35 participants. This is due to the amazing experience that is provided and how often the trip is made accessible. While the trip was designed for seniors any one can participate and all are welcome from any town.

The next trip to Atlantic City is on Monday August 22nd, trips are every third Monday of the month. The bus leaves at 8:30 a.m. and returns at 7:30 p.m. It is important to call and reserve your seat, especially during these summer months, or you risk the chance of being turned away. ### **MOTHER LAUNCHES LOCAL AUTISM SEARCH DIRECTORY**

Officially NeedQuest.com is an innovative take on something that's become quite familiar in the 21st century: the online local search directory.

However, what sets NeedQuest apart from other similar websites is two-fold. In addition to being a community-building site that directly connects parents of special needs children in the greater Westfield area with reputable service providers located right in their backyards, this new website is also founded by a local parent of a special needs child.

"My 14 year-old son, Jack, was diagnosed at age three with an autism spectrum disorder," says

launched this past April, Leslie Crowe, Founder of NeedQuest LLC. "At herself combing the Internet in search of answers that time, I was told by our public school district for, as well as her own anxiety and despair in Brooklyn to locate a Special Education Itinerant Teacher (SEIT) on my own. It was quite a jarring experience because I didn't know where to begin! The internet? The yellow pages? Our pediatrician? I really had no idea."

> months before they could find an appropriate professional. Thereafter, locating an appropriate school for Jack took another three years. Over time, as Jack grew, so did his needs. From therapy to after school programs, summer camps and more, the list of concerns that Crowe found

steadily increased.

"I know there are a lot of special needs parents looking for resources for their children," Crowe says. "However, I could not fathom that there wasn't a more efficient tool to navigate the For Crowe and her son Jack, it took four more Internet while searching for local providers to meet our children's needs. Eventually, after years of personal frustration, in 2015 I founded NeedQuest.com and committed myself to filling this void for the special needs community."

> When it comes to affirming the need for Crowe's mission, the numbers don't lie.

> According to the 2012 National Survey of Children with Special Health Care Needs (NSCSN), nearly 14 percent of children under 18 years of age in the United States, or approximately 10.2 million children overall, were estimated to have special health care needs. In New Jersey, the same study uncovered that out of the state's 1.5 million school-aged children, the number of children reported to have a disability is 4.5 percent, or 67,772 children overall.

> 32 percent of parents spend more than 40 hours per week with their special needs child or the amount of time equal to a second full-time job.

> As such, helping her fellow special needs parents ease these kinds of concerns has become a driving force for Crowe.

> "Parents are looking for services and providers at a time in their lives when they have the least amount of energy," she emphasizes. "With NeedQuest, we're aiming to be a catalyst for change when it comes to northern New Jersey special needs search - and hopefully, we'll make everyone's life, both parents and providers a little easier."






