Eagle Scout candidate Kevin Micheludis recently completed his Eagle Scout Project, beautifying the landscaping around the Clark Community Pool entrance and exit signs on Oak Ridge Road.

Micheludis approached Clark Recreation Director Ralph Bernardo in April, 2016 to discuss his project proposal. The project included the installation of 3 brick retaining wall/planter boxes, plants, and landscaping rocks. Micheludis solicited material donations from Home Depot in Colonia. He then organized and supervised a team of 25 volunteers including other scouts,

adult leaders, friends and members of his immediate family.

Eagle Scout is the highest advancement rank in Boy Scouting. To earn the rank, a Boy Scout must progress through the ranks of Tenderfoot, Second Class, First Class, Star, and Life Scout, earn a minimum of 21 merit badges and serve in a position of responsibility within his troop. The scout must also plan, execute and give leadership to others in the completion of a community service project.

Micheludis is a senior at Arthur L. Johnson High School in Clark.

CLARK GRADUATE ON BOOK SIGNING TOUR

Kelly Bennett, Arthur L. Johnson High School graduate from the Class of 1991, was known in high school for her brains and beauty. She achieved top grades and in her senior year and was named Homecoming Queen. Recently, her former classmates, neighbors and teachers got to reunite with her, seeing her now as a successful author. She had a book signing event on July 6 at the Barnes & Noble in Clark where she spoke, entertained questions and caught up with old friends.

Mrs. Kelly (Bennett) Seiler, now a Texas resident and mother of three, spoke to a standing-room-only crowd at the Clark bookstore where she explained how she got to the place of being a

novelist with Simon and Schuster. After graduating Bucknell University with a Bachelor's degree and her Master's degree in English and becoming an English teacher and a guidance counselor, she realized her passion was writing. Through a series of rejections balanced with encouraging events, she got an agent who challenged her to change the movie script she had submitted into a novel.

That suggestion became the acclaimed book, *Shifting Time*. At the event, the author read passages from her book and explained to the audience that the "What if?" supposition of the book was based on a real life. "When I was a teenager, there was a boy I loved who died of

cancer," she explained. She always wondered what life would have been like if he had lived and they had married. She told the audience, "Things might not always turn out the way your fantasy expects."

Mrs. Bennett Seiler jokingly warned her friends and other audience members that she takes every day happenings from friends and neighbors as well as strangers to flesh out her books. "I have even taken to Facebook to ask people to give me the name of a character," she said.

Her upcoming book, *The Plan*, will be released in September.



CLARK POLICE DEPARTMENT WARNS OF IRS SCAM - PROTECT YOURSELF

The Clark Township Police Department has noticed an increase in calls regarding telephone fraud. Specifically, individuals will target residents by posing as IRS Agents or other law enforcement officers. The callers will then demand that the person answering the phone send them money via Western Union, Money Gram or a similar electronic transfer service. The callers often claim that the money must be transferred to avoid an arrest warrant being issued for the victim. In addition, the callers will sometimes claim that the money is needed for bail for a family member. It is important to keep in mind that no legitimate agency will ever contact you over the phone regarding a debt; such correspondence is always done via the mail. Also, any money that you transfer, most likely, will never be recovered, as it is sent outside of the United States almost immediately.

If you receive such a call, do not transfer any type of money or divulge any personal information for any reason. Simply, hang up the phone. If you receive such a call and have any questions, you can contact the police desk at the non-emergency number 732-388-3434. Please read the following article for further tips!

IRS Urges Public to Stay Alert for Scam Phone Calls

IRS Special Edition Tax Tip 2015-18, October 21, 2015

The IRS continues to warn consumers to guard against scam phone calls from thieves intent on stealing their money or their identity. Criminals pose as the IRS to trick victims out of their money or personal information. Here are several tips to help you avoid being a victim of these scams:

- Scammers make unsolicited calls. Thieves call taxpayers claiming to be IRS officials. They demand that the victim pay a bogus tax bill. They con the victim into sending cash, usually through a prepaid debit card or wire transfer. They may also leave "urgent" callback requests through phone "robo-calls," or via phishing email.
- Callers try to scare their victims. Many phone scams use threats to intimidate and bully a victim into paying. They may even threaten to arrest, deport or revoke the license of their victim if they don't get the money.
- Scams use caller ID spoofing. Scammers often alter caller ID to make it look like the IRS or another agency is calling. The callers use IRS titles and fake badge numbers to appear legitimate. They may use the victim's name, address and other personal information to make the call sound official.
- Cons try new tricks all the time. Some schemes provide an actual IRS address where they tell the victim to mail a receipt for the payment they make. Others use emails that contain a fake IRS document with a phone number or an email address for a reply. These scams often use official IRS letterhead in emails or regular mail that they send to their victims. They try these ploys to make the ruse look official.
- Scams cost victims over \$23 million. The Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration, or TIGTA, has received reports of about 736,000 scam contacts since October 2013. Nearly 4,550 victims have collectively paid over \$23 million as a result of the scam.

The IRS will not:

- Call you to demand immediate payment. The IRS will not call you if you owe taxes without first sending you a bill in the mail.
- Demand that you pay taxes and not allow you to question or appeal the amount you owe.
- Require that you pay your taxes a certain way. For instance, require that you pay with a prepaid debit card.
- Ask for your credit or debit card numbers over the phone.
- Threaten to bring in police or other agencies to arrest you for not paying.

If you don't owe taxes, or have no reason to think that you do:

- Do not give out any information. Hang up immediately.
- Contact TIGTA to report the call. Use their "IRS Impersonation Scam Reporting" web page. You can also call 800-366-4484.
- Report it to the Federal Trade Commission. Use the "FTC Complaint Assistant" on FTC.gov. Please add "IRS Telephone Scam" in the notes.

MOTHER LAUNCHES LOCAL AUTISM SEARCH DIRECTORY

Officially launched this past April, NeedQuest.com is an innovative take on something that's become quite familiar in the 21st century: the online local search directory.

However, what sets NeedQuest apart from other similar websites is two-fold. In addition to being a community-building site that directly connects parents of special needs children in the greater Westfield area with reputable service providers located right in their backyards, this new website is also founded by a local parent of a special needs child.

"My 14 year-old son, Jack, was diagnosed at age three with an autism spectrum disorder," says Leslie Crowe, Founder of NeedQuest LLC. "At that time, I was told by our public school district in Brooklyn to locate a Special Education Itinerant Teacher (SEIT) on my own. It was quite a jarring experience because I didn't know where to begin! The internet? The yellow pages? Our pediatrician? I really had no idea."

For Crowe and her son Jack, it took four more months before they could find an appropriate professional. Thereafter, locating an appropriate school for Jack took another three years. Over time, as Jack grew, so did his needs. From therapy to after school programs, summer camps and more, the list of concerns that Crowe found herself combing the Internet in search of answers for, as well as her own anxiety and despair steadily increased.

"I know there are a lot of special needs parents looking for resources for their children," Crowe says. "However, I could not fathom that there wasn't a more efficient tool to navigate the Internet while searching for local providers to meet our children's needs. Eventually, after years of personal frustration, in 2015 I founded NeedQuest.com and committed myself to filling this void for the special needs community."

When it comes to affirming the need for Crowe's mission, the numbers don't lie.

According to the 2012 National Survey of Children with Special Health Care Needs (NSCSN), nearly 14 percent of children under 18 years of age in the United States, or approximately 10.2 million children overall, were

estimated to have special health care needs. In New Jersey, the same study uncovered that out of the state's 1.5 million school-aged children, the number of children reported to have a disability is 4.5 percent, or 67,772 children overall.

32 percent of parents spend more than 40 hours per week with their special needs child or the amount of time equal to a second full-time job.

As such, helping her fellow special needs parents ease these kinds of concerns has become a driving force for Crowe.

"Parents are looking for services and providers at a time in their lives when they have the least amount of energy," she emphasizes. "With NeedQuest, we're aiming to be a catalyst for change when it comes to northern New Jersey special needs search - and hopefully, we'll make everyone's life, both parents and providers a little easier."






