GIRL SCOUT COLLECTING BOOKS FOR 5TH GRADE STUDENTS

Katie Zimmermann, a 16-year-old Girl Scout with the Mountainside Ambassador Girl Scout Troop 40851, has chosen collecting books for the 5th Grade students at George Washington School in Hillside as her Girl Scout Gold Award Project.

"Super Storm Sandy in 2012 flooded Hillside's Public Library, which has still not fully recovered, and students in the school are urged to share books with their neighbors because they are scarce. My goal is to collect a minimum of 350 new or gently used books in the fifth to eighth grade reading levels to help alleviate this problem, and I need the help and support of the community," Zimmermann explained.

The teen explained that she plans to set up a "Book Bandy" location in the Hillside school where students can select a book and will not have to return it until they are finished reading it, because they won't be restricted by a due date. "The books will include a review sticker with a 5 Star Rating Scale to encourage discussion. The kids will see what their classmates thought about different books and that will help them decide what to read. The Book Bandy also will allow students to try different types of books with no pressure of time or commitment. If they start a book and don't like it, they can return it and select another. They can keep the books as long as they want because these books are meant for pleasure reading.

"Hopefully, this will encourage students to try larger and more challenging books than they might otherwise not be able to finish in a prescribed time frame," said. Zimmermann, an avid reader. The real focus of the "Book Bandy" is to foster a love of reading that the fifth graders will carry forward as they continue through high



school and beyond. She is reaching out to publishing companies for book donations and has placed a collection bin in the Mountainside Library to collect books. "From my own reading experience, when I finish a book I try to pass it on to someone else. My Book Bandy presents the perfect solution to what to do with a book you purchased when you're finished. Also, for those who would be willing to donate to this project, but don't have any books in these reading levels, an Amazon Wish List has been created by the school's fifth graders and their teachers. Interested residents can use the link <http://amzn.com/w/1F1REPWY2JHXH> to purchase a book from the list. Also, there are other ways to contribute to this worthy cause by donating other reading-related supplies," she explained.

Zimmermann said she hopes to reach her goal and realizes it can be done with just one book at a time. For more information, please contact her via email at katiezim18@gmail.com.

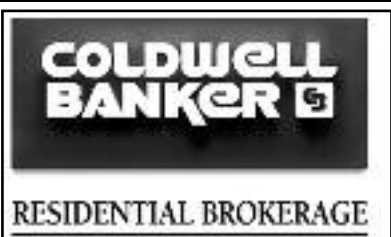

MOUNTAINSIDE'S HISTORIC LEVI CORY HOUSE

The long-awaited move of Mountainside's historic Levi Cory House took place on Saturday, November 2, 2013. During that morning, the house made its way north on New Providence Road toward its final destination, Constitution Plaza adjacent to the Mountainside Library and the Deacon Andrew Hetfield House.

This historic property on the corner of New Providence Road and Mountain Avenue (2 New Providence Rd.) in Mountainside was sold in the summer of 2013. The seller and buyer graciously agreed to allow the Mountainside Restoration Committee to take possession of the landmark structure located on the property and save it by moving it to a secure location.

The structure (circa 1810-1818), which was most recently the home of Patterson Interiors preceded by Barrett & Crain Realtors, was originally owned by the Woodruff family who were prominent members of the "West Fields" of Elizabethtown and Mountainside communities. Levi Cory once owned the house and rented it (in 1892) to the founders of the "Children's Country Home" as a summer retreat for inner city children. In 1962, the Children's Country Home was renamed the Children's Specialized Hospital, the largest rehabilitation children's hospital in the nation.

Because of its significance in the history of the Mountainside/Westfield area, the Mountainside Restoration Committee took on the task of moving the house to save it from destruction. The Borough of Mountainside allowed the Committee to use borough-owned property located on Constitution Plaza between the Mountainside Fire Department and Mountainside Library to situate the Levi Cory house placing it next door to Mountainside's Deacon Andrew Hetfield House, a very suitable neighbor.

The Mountainside Restoration Committee continues to rely on donations and fund raising

to support the continued restoration of the Levi Cory House the preparation required to allow the house to be opened to the public. This restoration and preparation includes exterior repair, interior repair, installation of utilities, installation of porch and door, and furnishings. The Mountainside Restoration Committee is a 501(c)(3) charity and donations are tax-deductible. Since the Mountainside Restoration Committee is an all-volunteer committee, 100% of the proceeds will go toward costs associated with the restoration and preparation of the Levi Cory House.

Since the 2013 move of the Levi Cory House, private donations; and grant money from the 1772 Foundation and the Westfield Service League have resulted in a new roof, repaired fascia, repaired foundation sill, removal of bow window, replacement of cedar siding and stairs to the basement crawl space. Much more is needed to restore the structure so it can open as a museum for children's interests, a consignment boutique and a community meeting place.

The Mountainside Restoration Committee (aka the Mountainside Historic Committee) is a committee of volunteers governed by the Borough of Mountainside whose purpose is to maintain the Deacon Andrew Hetfield House, save the Levi Cory House and collect and save historic information and items from destruction. 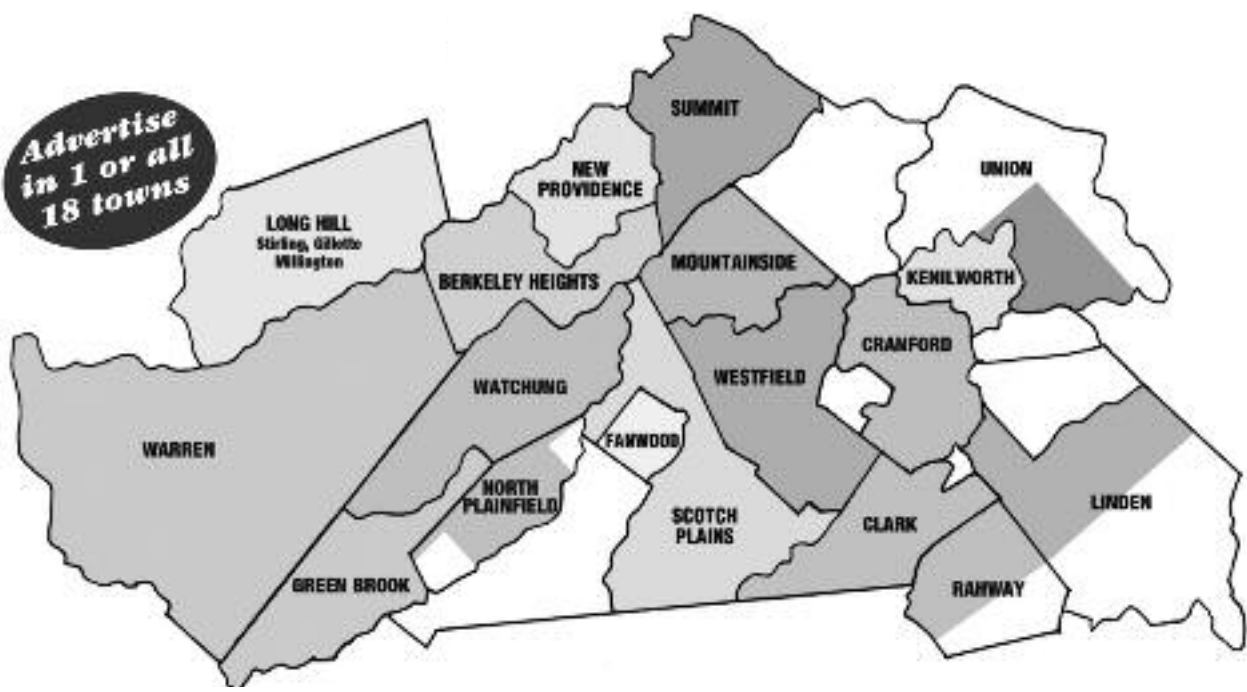

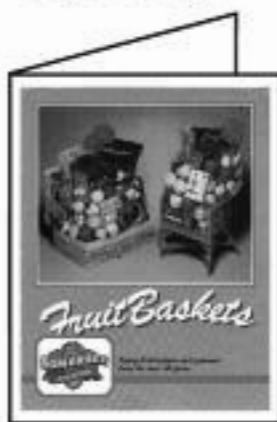

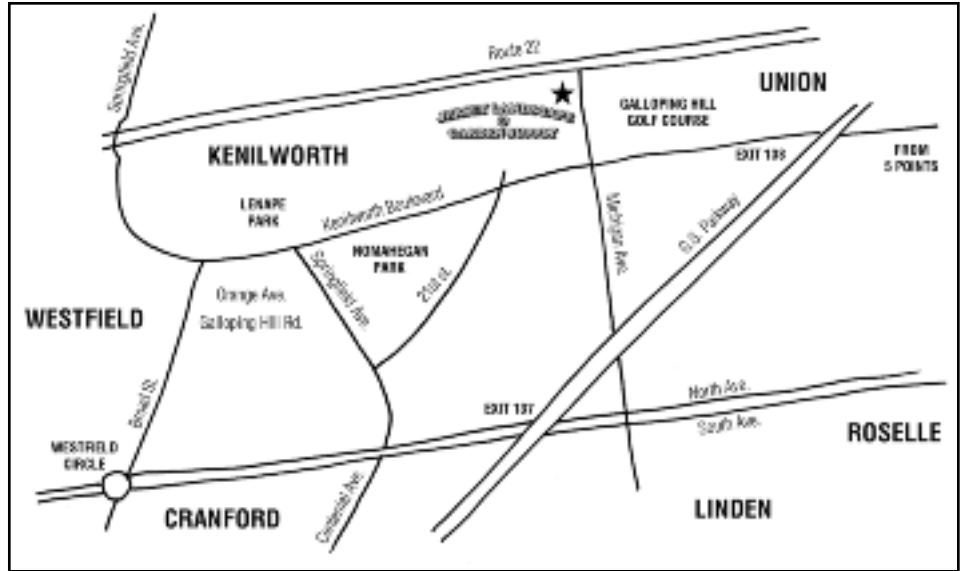
