FUND RAISER TO BE HELD FOR JACK SHEEHY ON SEPT 30TH

Jack Sheehy passed away on August 8th, 2016. He was born in Ft. Campbell, Ky., moved to Linden as a child, and graduated from Linden High School in 1976. Jack, along with his brother and father owned Sheehy's Reliable Tire Service on St. Georges Avenue for 40 years, Jack retired in 2014. He was a fair man – sometimes maybe too fair – often undercharging for the work he did. Jack was the beloved husband of 30 years to Linda Hesse Sheehy. They had 4 children, Jaclyn, Katelyn, Dayna and John.

On Jack's memorial page his children shared in part "Just be yourself," an infamous Jack Sheehy one liner that he slipped in any change he could. Three simple words filled with honesty, compassion, pride, courage and of course "Jack," my dad, our dad – the man, the myth, the legend."

Jack loved Linden and wanted to give back to his community, so he ran for 7th ward councilman in 2008 and won. He served the residents of that ward selflessly for two terms until 2013. Jack was also a member of the Linden Loyal Order of Moose Club and many other organizations.

Sadly, Jack had some significant setbacks in his life. His home, which he worked very hard for, incurred heavy damage during Superstorm Sandy in 2012 and his health declined further. Besides having to endure dialysis every other day, Jack developed substantial issues with blood circulation due to kidney disease. After several operations to save his left leg the doctors amputated it below the knee. However, his problems did not end there. While recovering, he took a fall that caused the healing incision on his amputated leg to split open requiring his devoted wife to leave her job so she could be a fulltime caregiver. It took some time before his left leg began to heal properly, but then tragedy struck again. He began having the same type of issues with his right leg. Unfortunately, he lost that leg as well. Again he faced a slow, hard recovery and was in the initial stages of being measured for his prostheses when his difficult journey ended on August 8th with his passing. Jack is at peace now. His suffering has ended.

BACK-TO-SCHOOL TIME FOR FOSTER YOUTH, TOO

Just as the kids head back to school, you may find yourself with more free time — and thrilled at the possibilities! How about changing the life of an area foster child? Train in Westfield later this month with like-minded locals and enjoy a light dinner, guest speakers and a team of trainers that equip you with all the tools needed to become a successful Court Appointed Special Advocate (CASA) volunteer. While many Linden students happily settle into school routines, buoyed by active parents readying for Back to School Night, there are foster youth without that support system who face educational challenges. Your commitment to their success helps ensure access to an education that meets their specialized needs:

Five-year-old Samantha is severely autistic and almost completely nonverbal. Due to excessive violence in the family home, a concerned neighbor called for help and, after investigation, Samantha was removed from her

Linden residents needed to serve as advocates parents' care and placed in foster care. Although primarily nonverbal, the two phrases Samantha does say graphically depict the violence she witnessed at home and confirm the trauma she endured. Since entering care, it has become clear Samantha also is a victim of educational neglect. At age three, Samantha was entitled to an Individualized Education Plan from the Department of Education to ensure continued inhome speech and behavioral services to move her toward enrollment in a half-day educational program. Unfortunately, Samantha's parents neglected to utilize these services and she is now two years behind others her age! A CASA volunteer can advocate for Samantha's educational rights and needed services, among other things, and make recommendations to the family court judge that will ensure her best interests remain prioritized.

CASA of Union County is seeking Linden residents to be the voice for one of the nearly

600 Union County youth, ages 0-21, in foster care through no fault of their own, as there are currently only enough volunteers to serve one-third of those youth. Trained CASA volunteers are sworn in by a judge and empowered to speak to foster parents, teachers, doctors, lawyers, tutors, therapists and more. They visit the youth regularly, incorporate findings into court reports and attend court hearings quarterly, working to ensure best interests are considered and a safe and permanent home is secured as quickly as possible. Although not required, there is a particular need for advocates who speak Spanish.

Fall training kicks off Tuesday, Sept. 27, 2016 and includes 10 sessions over several weeks. A swearing-in at the Union County Courthouse by a family court judge and luncheon follows. Training is 6 to 9 p.m. at the County Clerk Building, 300 North Avenue East in Westfield, across from the diner. A light dinner is provided.




