SIX TROOP 68 BOY SCOUTS ACHIEVE RANK OF EAGLE SCOUT

At two Courts of Honor, six Boy Scouts from Troop 68 in Berkeley Heights were recognized for achieving the rank of Eagle Scout. Andrew and William Clark, Eric Matrone, Pierre Arca-Sedda, Colin Hegarty and Nick Young each earned 13 required and 8 elective merit badges, provided leadership to their troop, and also planned and led others to complete a significant service project in their community.

Scoutmaster Cliff Boldt said of them "Over the last two years, 11 of our 12 Troop 68 graduating senior Scouts earned the Eagle rank. Like their predecessors, these six not only reached Boy Scouting's highest rank, but are also excellent students, strong athletes, and active in clubs and other organizations. Earning Eagle Scout is just one of their many accomplishments."

William Clark restored and improved a riding and nature trail behind the Littell-Lord Farmstead in Berkeley Heights. He will attend Boston University to study civil engineering.

Andrew Clark's project focused on rebuilding picnic tables at the Berkeley Heights Community Pool. He is attending the NYU Stern School of Business.

Eric Matrone designed and built a Bird Information Kiosk

at the Wagner Farm Arboretum and filled it with information about local birds. He is studying mechanical engineering at Drexel.

Pierre Arca-Sedda built picnic tables and basketball court benches for William Woodruff School in Berkeley Heights. Pierre is studying computer science and engineering at Rutgers.

Nick Young replaced a footbridge over a creek and renovated the adjoining trail on the property of Little Flower Church in Berkeley Heights. Nick will study computer engineering at the University of Michigan.

Colin Hegarty designed and built an outdoor "Pathway to the Future" at Thomas P. Hughes School in Berkeley Heights consisting of a series of stations describing alternative energy sources. Colin will be studying engineering at Cornell.

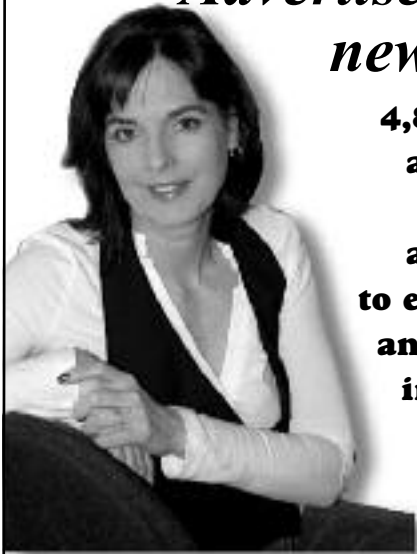

COLUMBIA SCHOOL FACULTY PARTICIPATE IN THE 25 MILE MS BIKE RIDE

Columbia Middle School Teachers Ashlee Smith and Noelle Fenimore recently embarked on the 25-mile Bike MS Country Challenge in support of those with Multiple Sclerosis. According to the Mayo Clinic, Multiple sclerosis (MS) is a potentially disabling disease of the brain and spinal cord (central nervous system). The bike ride was hosted by the National Multiple Sclerosis Society and according to the nonprofit their mission states “people affected by MS can live their best lives as we stop MS in its tracks, restore what has been lost and end MS forever.” The bike ride is a fund raiser to help with research, programs, and to raise awareness.

Ashlee and Noelle were made aware of the event by Ashlee's sister, Sara Smith, who works for the National MS Foundation and organized the event. Ashlee organized the team in Berkeley Heights and recruited Noelle, and others like Principal and Vice Principal Frank G. Geiger and Grace Acosta, respectively. The team didn't train together, but worked well together, even though this was their first time being involved in an event of this nature, but it won't be their last. The team plans on possibly training together in the future for other rides.

They already have the next ride planned out, which will be held down the New Jersey shore during the spring. Their hopes are to possibly recruit more staff members, students, and their families to join their ranks. The route, explains Noelle, is flat and wouldn't be as difficult as the 25-mile hilly course that they completed in the Berkeley Heights area.

Noelle and Ashlee are more than co-workers, they are good friends and when Ashlee approached Noelle about the event, Noelle agreed, but didn't even own a bike at the time. She now feels that purchasing a bike and agreeing to participate in the event was one of the best investments she has ever made. Noelle contributed to a worthy cause and is now involved in a new hobby, which she thoroughly enjoys.

Word spread throughout the school about their accomplishment and the students are amazed at what their educators have achieved. Apart from what the team at Columbia Middle School have done and what they will do in the spring down at the shore, they also participated in the Walk/Bike to school day on Oct 5th. Ashlee and Noelle biked from their apartment and met up with Frank and Grace, together they all biked amongst their students to school.

RESCUE SQUAD KEEPING COMMUNITY MEMBERS SAFE SINE 1942

Across America there are community members who answer the call for help from their fellow citizens and invest their time for the betterment of others. The EMT volunteers of Berkeley Heights have been doing this since 1942 and have been keeping the community safe. If needed, they offer assistance to surrounding towns like New Providence and Long Hill Township, and others.

Their service area extends down to Route 78 and, no matter what the time, these local heroes are always available, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. They are at their best, when others might be at their worst.

The Berkeley Heights Rescue Squad (BHVR) is an essential part of the community and provides services free of charge, where some cities send a bill to their patients. The medical equipment used by the Squad is primarily paid for by tax-deductible donations. According to the Berkeley Heights Municipal website, the town has a population of 13,345 and is about 6.3 square miles. BHVR responds to over 800 phone calls a year. EMT members who are over the age of 18 and are certified by the State of NJ, dedicate an average of 12 hours a week, plus two 6-hour weekend shifts. Although these hours are required to be an EMT within the rescue squad, whenever a member is called on for extra hours,

they rarely say no.

Younger members, under the age of 18, are classified as cadets, even if EMT certification has been acquired. Nicole Segalini, of Berkeley Heights, a high school student who is a certified EMT cadet at the Rescue Squad, decided to join in January of this year. Nicole, who is fascinated by the medical world, was encouraged to join by the Rescue Squad Chief, Samantha Lloyd. Nicole earned her EMT certification at Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital, where a minimum of 150 hours of classes are required. She is looking forward to becoming a full member after she graduates from high school. Currently she is required, like all cadets, to dedicate a minimum of 3 hours a week. Some cadets, like Nicole, take on weekend shifts also. Nicole, for example, rides up to 6 hours a week.

When first joining BHVR every member needs to take a first aid and a CPR class for the Professional Rescuer. These classes are provided by BHVR member and Vehicle Lt, Bill Schulz, a certified American Red Cross instructor. This allows members to ride on the ambulance and respond to calls. Once a month Bill and Samantha organize cadet meetings where they hold training sessions, providing recruits with scenarios that the cadets may not have seen. Any member wishing to become a NJ certified EMT must attend/pass a state certified basic EMT

course and pass the state exam.

The Berkeley Heights Rescue Squad is a focal point in the community, not only providing medical treatment when needed, but also participating in local community events such as 5K races, the Holiday Tree Lighting and Winter Walk, GL football games and visits to various BH schools. This year the Rescue Squad attended the Mount Carmel Festival and Bikers for Brooke, a yearly motorcycle ride in memory of Brooke Healey held to help raise awareness for her rare tumor, Diffuse Intrinsic Pontine Glioma or DIPG.

Currently the Berkeley Heights Rescue Squad has approximately 20 full-time members, 10 associates, and 8 cadets. While the Rescue Squad has a group of well trained professional EMTs, they are always looking for citizens too step-up and join the squad to help keep this great organization alive. The Rescue Squad is not only looking for volunteers to ride on the ambulance and provide care for those in need, but are also seeking Auxiliary members, those who just want to help out BHVR, but don't want to become EMTs.

SPOTLIGHT ON LOCAL ARTIST MIRON ABRAMOVICI

Berkeley Heights Resident, Miron Abramovici is an engineer by training, former professor at Columbia University, researcher at Bell Labs, and even wrote a computer engineering textbook. Most people would agree that Miron has had a successful and fulfilling life, but about eight years ago when Miron retired from his engineering career, he ventured outside his engineering world and into the world of art. Discovering his inner artist, Miron proceeded to teach himself the art of photography and the results have been quite impressive.

Almost immediately after Miron began expressing his artistic side through photography, he began to earn many awards including the 2009 Fine Art Photography Competition. The Fine Arts Photography awards are judged by a panel of industry professionals. Winners of the of the awards are given the title of either Professional Fine Art Photographer of the Year, or Amateur Fine Art Photographer of the Year, given cash prizes, have their artwork showcased, and given international publicity. In January 2011 Miron was awarded the NJ Artist of the Month; and then had one of his photos selected as Kodak Picture of the Day, which was then put on display on Time Square in August 2011, for people from all over to see. This year Miron had the honor of putting one his artworks on display when the Curatorial Assistant of the MOMA chose one of his images to be presented at the Brooklyn Waterfront Artists Coalition Gallery, a non-profit organization with the goal of showcasing

emerging artists and allowing easy access to modern art.

Miron most recently had his “Water Fall Colors” licensed by the Hilton Brooks Hills Resort in Oak Brook, Illinois for a 72"x48" photo, which will be mounted in the hotel next month. The art being displayed at the resort is a landscape photograph, but Miron doesn't consider himself a landscape photographer, he instead prefers the world of portraits, abstracts, and surrealism, an avant-garde art and literature form that seeks to release the creative potential of the unconscious mind.

When Miron creates his art, he begins by walking with his camera and a bit of instinct and foresight of how the image will look once he

transforms the photo using his image processing software. Miron plays close attention to an inner voice instructing him to click when he views something interesting, but he explains that interesting isn't just something nice or beautiful, it has to have a distinct and unusual quality to it.

More recently Miron has tried his creativity with sculptures and has had a curator from San Francisco select one of his sculptures for an exhibit at the Barrett Art Center in Poughkeepsie, NY. Miron has this to say about his artwork “I believe art needs no explanation, creating art brings me bliss,” and added this about art in general “Good art is something that talks to my soul and brings me joy,” an emotion he hopes to invoke in others.

BLOOD RESERVES CHALLENGED BY DEMAND O-NEGATIVE BLOOD A CONSTANT CHALLENGE

New Jersey Blood Services, a division of New York Blood Center (NYBC) is asking for help to maintain an adequate supply of all blood types, but especially O-negative – the “universal” blood which can be transfused into anyone in an emergency. In addition, hundreds of additional blood drives need to be scheduled to meet projected hospital demand. Current inventory of several blood types is running below the desired target level.

“It’s simple: hospital patient demand for blood often outpaces our best efforts to recruit donors and schedule blood drives,” said NYBC Executive Director of Donor Recruitment Andrea Cefarelli. “There are always reasons but we have to overcome that for the sake of hospital patients who need us.”

“This is one of the toughest times of the year,” Cefarelli added. “We’re asking for our dedicated supporters to roll up their sleeves to make sure we’re able to provide our hospital partners with whatever they need to take care of their patients.”

Blood products have a short shelf life – from five to 42 days, so constant replenishment is necessary. Each and every day there are patients who depend on the transfusion of red blood cells, platelets and plasma to stay alive. But blood and blood products can’t be manufactured. They can only come from volunteer blood donors who take an hour to attend a blood drive or visit a donor center.

To donate blood or for information on how to organize a blood drive Please call Toll Free: 1-800-933-2566 Visit: www.nybloodcenter.org. If

you cannot donate but still wish to participate in bringing crucial blood products to patients in need, please ask someone to donate for you, or consider volunteering at a local blood drive.

Any company, community organization, place of worship, or individual may host a blood drive. NYBC also offers special community service scholarships for students who organize community blood drives during summer months. Blood donors receive free mini-medical exams on site including information about their temperature, blood pressure and hematocrit level. Eligible donors include those people at least age 16 (with parental permission or consent), who weigh a minimum of 110 pounds, are in good health and meet all Food & Drug Administration and NY or NJ State Department of Health donor criteria. People over 75 may donate with a doctor's note.

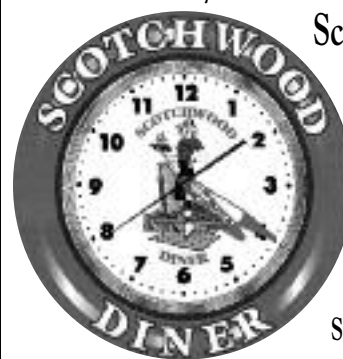

CIVIL AIR PATROL PROGRAM OF UNION COUNTY

The Civil Air Patrol Cadet Program of Union County ended their action packed summer by providing a presentation to community members in the Scotch Plains Library. The Civil Air Patrol is a non-combatant organization, which is an auxiliary of the Air force, made up of civilian volunteers. Cadets had the opportunity to teach local students about aerospace concepts, as well as give hands-on training on how to use a flight simulator. The purpose of the event was to serve as an outreach program to display what the cadet program encompasses, hopefully sparking some interest among the student population in Scotch Plains and the surrounding towns within Union County.

The day was broken down into two sections. The cadets first presented a PowerPoint explaining topics, such as how wings create lift; which, according to NASA, is a subject that many internet sources, textbooks, and encyclopedias get wrong. The theory NASA uses is what the cadets explained in their presentation, the Bernoulli's principle. NASA also refers to an Isaac Newton theory, but explains that the Bernoulli's theory is correct, along with Newton's theory. Other topics covered in the first session included the axis of an airplane and also the parts of an airplane that control maneuvers.

The second portion of the program was dedicated to more hands-on instruction. Students at the library were instructed on how to use flight simulators. Two simulators were used in the demonstration. Attendees could practice how to take off, land, fly, and could also learn the different instruments on a plane and how they

affect the planes movements. Afterwards, paper model rockets were displayed in order to teach basic principles of flight.

Jose and Ceri Vergara are in charge of the Civil Air Patrol. Ceri explains that the Civil Air Patrol began during World War II for the purpose of allowing civilians, who owned airplanes, to get involved. During the September 11th attacks, civilian airplanes were used for reconnaissance. The Civil Air Patrol Program has programs for both adults and teenagers, ages 12-18. Currently, the Civil Air Patrol Program of Union County has 6 adult members, these members are in charge of providing education and scheduling activities for the group. The group meets Tuesdays from 7-9 p.m. at Chatham High School.

Jose and Ceri were inspired to join the Civil Air Patrol by their daughter, Veronica Vergara, who attends Union County Vocational Technical School in Scotch Plains. Currently, Veronica is the elder of the cadets and has taken over as senior cadet.

Jose notes that countless students looking to go to college in the near future often seek extracurricular activities in order to stand out. This is where a program like Civil Air Patrol could be useful. Ceri feels that in addition to the program looking good on your resume, students also have the opportunity to learn and experience things that they might not in a regular school setting. One parent, Ceri recalls, stated at a parent's meeting, "This is the best kept secret in the United States!"

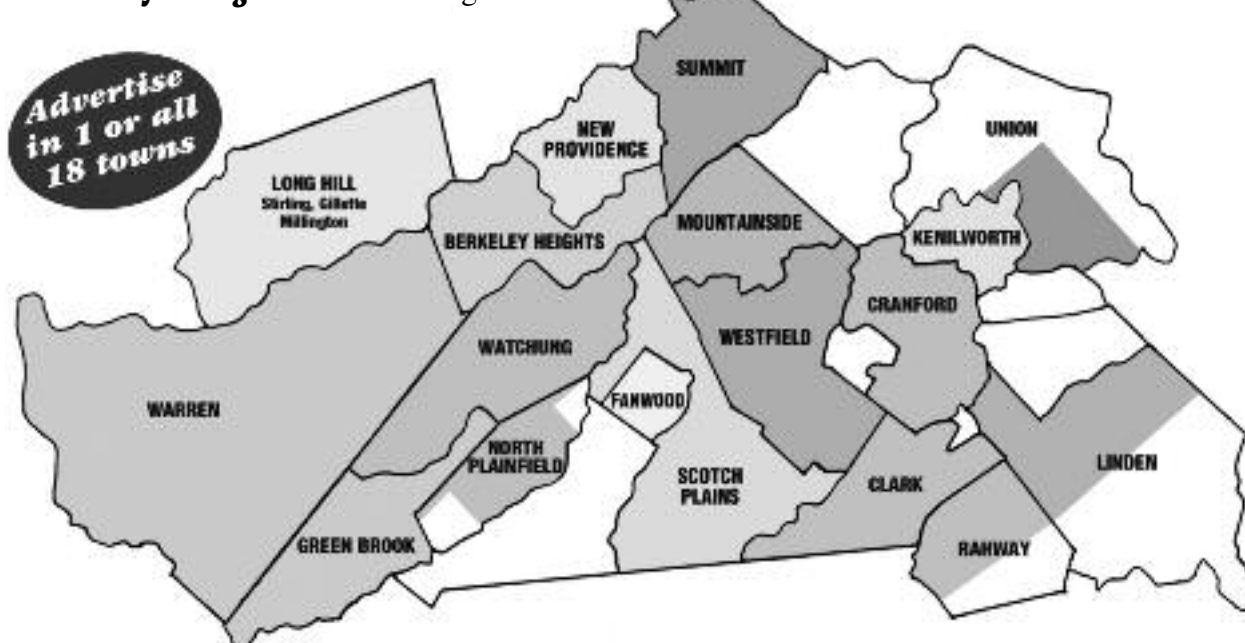

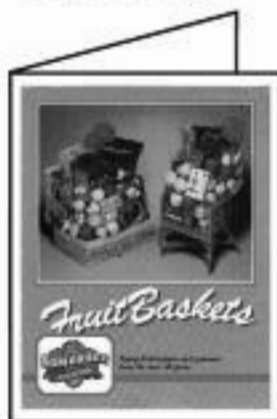
