## **LINKS MENTORING PROGRAM START NEW YEAR OF SERVICE**

The LINKS Mentoring Program at Frank K. Hehnly School had its initial kickoff with student mentors in September.

The activity provided an experience to help children understand the relationship between generalizations and stereotypes. Each group of students was given a lemon and was asked to describe its characteristics. Students studied the lemon and took note of all of its special features. The lemons were placed together in a bowl, and students were asked to identify theirs. Students understood that while all lemons may look alike, they are in fact uniquely different. Taking it further, Guidance Counselor, Sarah Badillo, and Learning Consultant, Lisa Giandana, asked students to think about how people might make assumptions about those with disabilities. Students shared that someone in a wheelchair may actually want to play basketball and that an autistic student probably does want a friend, even though they may have a bit of trouble making friends.

This program, run by Sarah Badillo and Lisa Giandana, provides training to young mentors and helps foster friendships in and out of school for students identified as needing social and emotional support.

#### **AUTHOR SPEAKS AT ALJ HIGH SCHOOL**







## TWP. OF CLARK PLANNING TO HOLD COMMUITY **EMERGENCY RESPONSE TRAINING PROGRAM**

The Township of Clark is planning on holding another Community Emergency Response Training (CERT) program to be held in the Fall 2016/Winter 2017 time period, if we get enough people interested.

We have previously conducted eleven classes for the general public and one class for various teachers and administrators in the Clark Public School System with good attendance in all the

The CERT concept dates back to 1985, when the Los Angeles Fire Department recognized that in the early stages of a major disaster local emergency responders could be overwhelmed, and basic training in disaster survival and rescue skills could improve the ability of community members to help themselves until first responders or other assistance arrived. This program, which now exists in every state, is promoted by the Federal Government through the Citizens Corp. program and the NJ State Police Office of Emergency Management. New Jersey presently ranks among the top states in the Country based on the number of CERT programs within each state.

This program is a 24 hr. training program, which is given over a 9-week period, that provides information on a variety of topics. Participants will receive training in such areas as; CERT team organization and Incident Command System, identifying hazards most likely to affect their homes or community and general disaster preparedness, basic fire knowledge, basic 1st aid training, light search & rescue training, disaster psychology, and terrorism. This program is not intended to train people to be First Responders for Fire or First Aid purposes, but it is designed to train people to be better able to help themselves and their families, to possibly help their neighbors, and, if they choose, to help their community by assisting the various township emergency services in a major emergency situation.

CERT members have helped greatly on a community level during several of the recent storms we have had and were used for a number of things such as: Staffing of our Emergency Operations Center or shelters, providing assistance or transportation to people who may have to evacuate their homes, or delivering pumps and/or generators to other residents in time of flooding or power outages.

Anyone interested in participating in this program should contact the Office of Emergency Management at 732-388-3600 Ext. 3007. Applicants must be at least 18 years old.

dedicated Rachel Bollaro, was featured throughout the event. Matthew Kowalenko, the new school DJ this year, provided music for the cheerleaders and teams.




Mr. Fosco, ALJ history teacher, was the official Master of Ceremonies for the rally.






# HEARING SOCIETY WEEKLY CLASSES

themes included that one person can make a difference and be nice to others inspiring students to reach out to their peers if they need a friend.


One of his hand-on activities required students to trace a hand on a brown paper bag and put it on their wall, so they could pat themselves on the back if no one else was around to do it.


#### MRS. CONNER'S STUDENTS "GOTTA REACH EM'ALL"




