LINDEN'S 65TH HALLOWEEN PARADE

This year, a wonderful autumn tradition will continue in Linden at the end of October.

On Sunday, October 30th at 2:00 p.m., marchers will step-off for the 65th edition of Linden's Halloween Parade. The parade will begin on South Wood Avenue near Route 1, and will proceed north toward City Hall and continue to Curtis Street. The total length of the march is approximately 1 mile.

According to the Parade Planning Committee, this year's parade will feature many new participants including municipal dignitaries, marching bands, decorated floats and performing groups. As in past years, most Linden schools are well represented with themed floats and children in costume. As is tradition, the end of the parade will feature a visit by Santa Claus to help officially kick-off the holiday season. "We're thrilled with the response we've gotten from our municipality, our schools, and generous sponsors. We were able to build the Line of March by approximately 40% over last year's parade" stated Carl Pereira, Linden Halloween Parade Committee President.

"We expect a large crowd of spectators this year, and they won't be disappointed" he said. Many marching groups will stop and perform in front of grandstands erected at City Hall near Wood Avenue and Knopf Street, and that's where crowds are usually the largest. Carl added, "This year we are very fortunate to have received donations from Linden's business and corporate community. Their gracious generosity exemplifies the dedication and desire to keep a great Linden tradition alive and well, year after year"

The parade has always named a Grand Marshal, honoring an individual who has given of their time and generosity in helping to continue the legacy of the event. This year the committee has chosen the late Jack Sheehy as posthumous Grand Marshal. Mr. Sheehy was a past Committee member, parade volunteer, and former Councilman of Linden's 7th ward.



The theme for this year's parade will be to honor Linden's First Responders – Linden Police Department, Linden Fire Department, Linden OEM, and Linden 911 Dispatchers. The Halloween Parade Planning Committee will continue to meet every Wednesday at 7:00PM, at the JTG Recreation Center on Helen Street. Volunteers are always welcome. UNITED METHODIST CHURCH OPEN HEARTS. OPEN MINDS. OPEN DOORS. - 150TH YEAR CELEBRATION 1866 - 2016-

The United Methodist Church of Linden is the oldest Church in the City of Linden, having been incorporated on September 25, 1866. People began midweek prayer meetings in local homes and few years later Sunday services began in private houses. By 1873, Methodists of Linden purchased an old school house located in North Stiles Street, near the corner of what is now Knopf Street. In 1881, the old school house was moved to the present location. In 1889 a full time ordained pastor was appointed. The official board minutes of October 8, 1913 make the first mention of both Boy Scouts and Camp Fire Girls.

July 6, 1925, the new and present church building started. The church attendance was about 240. New Church building's cornerstone was laid on September 20, 1925, and the first service was on Sunday, March 28, 1926.

The church has faithfully worked in the community with a deep interest in the youth, helping needy people in Linden through the Bountiful Basket program and Care Boxes.

Coming into Millennia, church has paid attention to changes in surrounding communities. With easy access of public transportation, urbanizing surrounding towns, closing of large corporations, and thousands losing jobs, the

church has responded to various ethnic families, welcoming multi-cultural, multi-ethnic groups. Church has missional vision of working hand in hand with other local churches by sharing of place of worship to grow Christian faith and ministries. In 2015, a new daycare center was opened as a part of church mission and ministry in the community.

As we remember the past, in celebrating our 150th year anniversary, we also look forward to the future, when others will continue the history of the United Methodist Church here in the City of Linden. We will always continue to serve God, our Church family and the community.

In 1917 a businessman in Chicago, Melvin Jones, decided to rally other businessmen to join in an effort to help those in need in their community. From that humble beginning Lions Clubs sprung up all over the United States and then all over the world. Today there aare 1.3 million members in more than 45,000 clubs. In 1925 Hellen Keller addressed the Lions at an

International Convention and challenged them to become "knights of the blind". Since then the Lions have worked tirelessly to aid the blind and visually impaired. After launching SightFirst in 1990, more than \$346 million was raised to prevent major causes of blindness globally: cataract, trachoma, river blindness, childhood blindness, diabetic retinopathy, and glaucoma.

The Lions were one of the first nongovernmental organizations invited to assist in the drafting of the United Nations Charter in 1945 and have supported the work of the UN ever since. Lions are the only charitable organization recognized by the United Nations with a special day at the UN every year.

Lions Clubs International Foundation, established in 1968, meets the needs of global and local communities in times of disasters such as hurricanes, floods, and fires. The motto of the Lions is "We Serve", and we continue to extend

our mission of service in all corners of the globe.

Over the years, Linden Lions have supported any organizations that provides assistance to the blind such as Camp Marcella (a camp for blind children), Camp Happiness (for blind adults), St. Joseph School for the Blind, Union County Blind Association, Mavis (music school for the blind or visually impaired), eyeglasses for needy children, collected thousands of used eyeglasses which are recycled and sent overseas. We have also provided many scholarships and supported numerous other charitable endeavors.
