#### **COMMUNITY GARDEN IS COMMUNITY CORNERSTONE**

On a hot Saturday afternoon on September 10th, Rahway gardeners gathered around at the new Rahway garden located across the street from the JFK Community Center, in the Friendship Baptist Church lot, to celebrate the fruit of their labor. David Brown, Fourth Ward Municipal Council member had put together the city's second community garden, with the backing of the city's residents and Mr. Brown's colleagues. Master Gardner Debra Stuart had been invited to the garden by Mr. Brown in the spring of 2015, during which there were only 10 beds, one of which was rented out by Debra. In an effort to teach kids the importance of vegetation and gardening, Mr. Brown enlisted Debra to instruct the children how grow vegetables, flowers, and fruits. Debra was more than happy to oblige and after several meetings, in order to have the proper tools to teach the children, the gardeners had installed 30 additional beds. This allowed Debra to have an area to teach the children.

Mr. Brown chose the perfect person to teach the children, Debra has been a gardener since she was a child and has been exposed to gardens with vegetables and flowers throughout her entire childhood. She currently holds the title of Vice President of Rahway Garden Club and became a certified Master Gardener in 2015 as well as Master Tree Steward in 2015. Part of the reason Debra enjoys working in the garden and teaching children is because of what the garden itself encourages. When a person grows their own

vegetation, it sparks their curiosity, prompting them to learn something about the plant, the insects, or possible diseases. Gardening also promotes community unity according to Debra. During her time at different community gardens, she has met many different gardeners and in those encounters they've shared each other's harvest, traded recipes, and tips on how to grow different plants.

The building of the garden itself helps bring people together because creating a garden takes a community effort. The carpenters who build the soil beds were from Kenilworth and supply donations came from local business around the City of Rahway. Debra express, "it is more than just the garden, it is a team of businesses and people working together." The success of the community garden has been great and there are hopes in building a new community garden. The more gardens that are created the more food citizens can grow for themselves, which would in turn supplement their food bill.

The children are just as excited as the adults about the new garden. Throughout the summer, these young gardeners have begun planting seedlings, learning about the importance of insects and how they pollinate the flowers, as well gained the appreciation for growing plants and flowers just to for their beauty. "The children have realized when they see the plants grow they have done something productive," expressed Debra.

Debra explains that without the Friendship Baptist Church, local businesses, UCMG Come grow with Us, and many others in the community the garden would've never happened.





#### WHAT'S IN A NAME? THAT WHICH WE CALL A PRISON BY ANY OTHER NAME...

Mention the name East Jersey State Prison and most wouldn't have a clue to what one was referring. Mention Rahway Prison, however, and there's a very good chance most people, even those living in states across the country, have heard of the notorious penal institution. For Rahway citizens, the name "Rahway Prison" has been a point of contention from the time the facility was opened.

In 1895 the New Jersey Legislature voted to establish the state's first reformatory to be built for young men between the ages of 16 and 30 who were found guilty of a first offense. The purpose was to provide a place where young men could be sent that would give them the greatest possibility to reform. The site chosen for the reformatory was a 300 acre tract of state-owned land located in the Avenel section of Woodbridge Township, Middlesex County. At the time, Avenel, which did not become an established community until 1901, was for the most part farmland and open space. Construction took three years and the facility opened on August 1, 1901. The new structure, with its large imposing dome and distinctive architecture, immediately became the most prominent landmark in the area.

The building complex encompassed 21 acres and included an administration building, cell houses, school rooms, a chapel, and other buildings which were surrounded by a large wall. Within the enclosure were athletic fields for baseball, football, softball, and soccer. The entire prison was surrounded by hundreds of acres of farmland that the inmates worked.

With rehabilitation being the primary purpose, a well-balanced and properly supervised program was offered. Vocational training included tailoring, cooking, shoemaking, printing, electric work, farming/gardening, plumbing, painting. Complete medical, psychological, and psychiatric facilities were provided. Attendance at religious services, offered for Protestant, Catholic, and Jewish inmates, was strongly encouraged, but optional.

By the late 1920s, with the construction of reformatories at Annandale and Bordentown, Rahway was upgraded and changed from a reformatory to a prison for adult males. Today, the maximum security penitentiary houses over 1,500 inmates.

From the time the reformatory opened in 1901, the name "Rahway" quickly became attached to it even though it was not in the city of Rahway nor was it even in Union County. Due to the fact that it was situated in rural, undeveloped Avenel, all mail sent to the facility was processed through the Rahway Post Office. Also, anyone visiting the reformatory via the railroad would alight at Rahway Station.

The consternation felt by Rahway citizens regarding the reformatory and later the prison is nothing new and has rankled residents from the time the institution received its first inmates. In a letter written to a local newspaper in 1927 a Rahwayan wrote in part, "Rahway is the target for all kinds of witticism and receives much

unfavorable criticism because of the misuse of the name... Outsiders probably have the idea that the outstanding feature of Rahway is the reformatory; that it occupies a site in the heart of the city; and that the whole business life of the city revolves around the institution... Certainly, being known as a reformatory town does not add to the attractiveness of a place. Indeed, it might very well prove a hindrance to the development of a town."

In the late 1970s and into the 1980s, an aggressive effort was finally made by city officials to get the name changed. On February 8, 1982 a resolution was introduced to the city council by Third Ward Councilman Max Sheld requesting the New Jersey Department of Corrections to give the facility an official name "that does not identify it with any geographical location." Five months later the Rahway measure

passed through the Assembly by a vote of 49-17. Legislators agreed that "By assigning a more regionalized name to the prison, we can hopefully prevent its proximity from distracting from the desirability of nearby communities." The wheels of government turn slowly, however, and it was not until five years later, on November 30, 1987, that a law was signed by Governor Thomas Kean to change the name to East Jersey State Prison.

Although the new name has officially been in use for almost 30 years, hardly anyone is heard referring to the place as East Jersey State. Unlike the Merchants and Drovers which is fondly remembered as the Girl Scout House or the Union County Performing Arts Center as the Rahway Theater, Rahway Prison is a term void of nostalgic sentiment. Unfortunately, it will probably take a few more generations before the misnomer is totally forgotten.





#### ORNAMENTAL KALE

Brassica oleracea

After Chrysanthemum flowers fade away and squirrels have eaten the pumpkins, 'Ornamental Kale' or 'Flowering Cabbage' still brings color to the late autumn garden. These beautiful plants are prized for their brightly colored foliage which becomes more intense when temperatures drop below 50 degrees.


Ornamental Kale is in the same family as cabbage, broccoli, cauliflower and collars. Although flowering kales are \*edible, it is not delicious and is best used as a garnish on the bottom of the plate.

When you buy Ornamental kale at your local garden center select plants close to the size you want them when mature. Once root bound they will not grow much more than they already have in the pot.

When you bring it home, plant them in the ground or transplant into another pot. Bury stems so that the lowest leaves are flush with the soil surface.

Ornamental kale requires a sunny location in a moderately moist rich soil. Keep the plants moist. Kale and cabbage do not tolerate drying out and will lose vigor quickly. Fully grown plants are approximately 15 inches tall and one foot wide.

When colder weather arrives pigments in the leaves will brighten, white pink or red. This is when they are at the peak of their display. In addition to color kale leaves have many shapes,

curly, frilly or ruffled.

There are many different cultivars available today, 'Peacock', 'Pigeon', 'Osaka' and the 'Tokyo' to name a few. Home gardeners have a large selection to choose from. Pick the plants most pleasing to your eyes.

You can start seeds ten weeks before the expected frost date or purchase plugs at your local garden center. Growing them can be fun but you will have to battle beetles and insects to prevent them from chewing holes in the leaves. I only have space for a few pots so I use this opportunity to support my local garden nurseries.

\*As noted above, ornamental kale and flowering cabbage plants are edible, but they are tough and bitter. To reduce their bitter taste, boil them, discard the water and then boil or sauté them in olive oil prior to serving.

'Miss' would definitely agree.




