

## **CRANFORD TROOP 75 VISITS WASHINGTON DC**

Washington DC. From early in the morning to late at night, the Scouts were on the move in our Nation's Capital.

After observing the hourly Changing of the Guard at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, the Scouts participated in a wreath-laying ceremony at the Tomb. Wanting to show their respect and honor to those who served and gave the ultimate sacrifice to defend our nation, Troop 75 invited Cranford VFW Post 335 to attend. Showing enthusiasm and gratitude for the invitation, the Post generously provided a wreath with the phrase: "In Honor of Those Who Gave Their



Cranford's Troop 75 spent a busy weekend in Lives so that We May Live Free." Led by the Sergeant of the Tomb Guard, VFW Post 335 Commander Jay Emmons Boxwell and Senior Vice Commander James Silkensen and Troop 75 Eagle Scout Timothy Joyce and Assistant Senior Patrol Leader Joseph Gannon performed an exemplary job representing Cranford's veterans and the Boy Scouts of America, respectively.

On a very tight schedule, the Scouts traveled afterward to Union Station for lunch. A short, pleasant walk in the Washington sunshine took them to the Capital Building for a guided tour, courtesy of Congressman Leonard Lance's office. The Capital Tour Staff was extremely happy to see the smartly uniformed Scouts, treating them with respect and honor. The Scouts enjoyed a stirring video about the history and significance of the Capital Building, a symbol bringing the People of this great Nation together, followed by a walk through the Crypt, the Rotunda, the National Statuary Hall and the Old Senate ("Whispering Gallery") Chamber. Each location was replete with statues representing significant people from each of the 50 States and their contributions to the growth of our Nation. An extremely knowledgeable Capital Tour Guide provided little-known facts and deftly fielded questions from the Scouts, weaving insights into his answers that helped everyone appreciate how our Country came to be.

After dinner at Union Station's Shake Shack, the Scouts spent a short time playing Frisbee in an adjacent park before starting a bus tour of the monuments. Under a bright, full October moon, with stops at the Martin Luther King, Franklin Delano Roosevelt, Marine Corp (Iwo Jima) and Lincoln Memorials, the Scouts received an inperson appreciation of the hard-won freedoms that we have today.

The "Monuments by Moonlight" tour bus driver "Sooner Steve" kindly drove the Troop back cross-town to their parking spot while giving a private tour of additional sites.

Troop 75 Scouts were courteous and respectful throughout the tour and received many encouraging unsolicited positive and compliments from every member of the Washington DC public, including Veteran, military, National Park and Capital Staff personnel.



#### ALIMONY STATUTE AMENDMENTS FROM 2014 CAN BE APPLIED TO DIVORCES FINALIZED YEARS EARLIER

Today's current economic reality is one of great uncertainty, especially when it comes to employment. Employees who could count on receiving an annual cost of living adjustment or performance bonus no longer have that luxury, nor the security that their years of experience and training will translate into an equal or higher-paying position should they lose their job. These realities of employment cut across the entire New Jersey labor market, yet they have an even deeper impact when faced by divorced individuals with existing alimony obligations.

Alimony, which is sometimes referred to as spousal support or maintenance, is defined as the obligation upon one spouse to provide financial support to his or her spouse before or after marital separation or divorce. In 2014 the New Jersey Legislature passed, and the Governor signed, an alimony reform bill which "modernized" how alimony awards are to be calculated. One change in the new alimony statute deals with how judges can interpret cases where the payor of alimony attempts to lower or all together eliminate their alimony obligations due to job loss.

Recently, a Superior Court judge in New Jersey rendered a decision effecting thousands of divorced spouses in our state. The judge's ruling confirmed for the first time that the 2014 alimony overhaul would not just apply to individuals divorced since the revisions were enacted two years ago, but to all divorced individuals currently paying or receiving alimony.

In Mills v. Mills the Court reviewed a petition made by the supporting spouse (the payor of alimony) to reduce their alimony obligation due to the loss of long-term employment and the acceptance of a new position at a considerably lower salary. The Court granted the petition to reduce the alimony obligation and held that under the 2014 amendments to the alimony statute, the family court has the authority to reduce alimony

obligations when the supporting spouse loses their employment and has made reasonable attempts to find alternative employment. The interesting thing about the Court's decision is that the Mills were divorced in 2013, one year before the alimony revisions were signed into law.

The Court in <u>Mills</u> found that judges have the authority to apply both the spirit and terms of the 2014 amendments to the alimony statute, even when the individuals had a final divorce order entered before 2014, so long as there is no written agreement applying a different standard in place, and the issue has not been litigated and already adjudicated by the Court. In so doing, the Court determined who could avail themselves of the remedies written into the new statutes. The Judge in Mills acknowledged that changes often occur in the employment status of individuals after they are divorced. This has become a more common occurrence over the past several years with the economic downturn and static recovery which has affected tens of thousands of individuals. The Judge specifically referred to the "harsh present day reality" which exists for many people who have lost their jobs and may never regain their former earning level.

## **ADVOCATES NEEDED FOR LOCAL FOSTER YOUTH**

CASA of Union County is seeking Cranford 12 — continues the traditional six-week format, residents to step up and be the voice for one of the nearly 600 Union County youth, ages 0-21, currently in foster care through no fault of their own.

Traditionally, the required 30-hour training is held over six weeks, with volunteers meeting several evenings each week. However, two new training options are now available, in response to prospective volunteers seeking more scheduling flexibility. A December training — which begins Monday, Dec. 5, 2016 — allows those home during the day to complete all training within five days from 9 am to 4 pm at the CASA offices; the January training — which begins Thursday, Jan.

but incorporates online learning at the volunteer's convenience, and fewer in-person sessions. Lunch or light dinner is provided. At the conclusion of training, a Superior Court judge swears in the new child advocates at the Union County Courthouse.

Trained CASAs are court-empowered to speak to foster parents, teachers, doctors, lawyers, therapists and more. CASAs visit the youth regularly and incorporate findings into a report for the judge. They attend quarterly court hearings, working to ensure a youth's time in care is as short as possible and their best interests remain the priority. Although not required, there is an additional need for male advocates and advocates who speak Spanish. Just who is a typical child referred to CASA of Union County? Meet 12-year-old Marissa:

When my mother was pregnant with me, she drank alcohol and used cocaine, and I was born with Fetal Alcohol Syndrome. Even though the state was working with my mom to help her get clean and be a better mom to me and my brother, she couldn't stay away from the drugs and

alcohol. My older brother tried to take care of me, but he said it was too hard, and our house was so dirty and cluttered. A worker from the state came and took me, and put me into a foster home. That worker left and I have a new worker. When I met her, she said the plan was for me to go back with my mom as soon as she's better. I was so happy. But I just found out that now my mom is missing! I'm so worried and hope she's okay. Is she drinking again? Is she hurt? Every day I wonder what will happen to me and what's happened to her. I'm so scared. I don't see my brother anymore at all. My family is so broken and I feel all alone.

## **THIRD UNION COUNTY DAY OF PRAYER DRAWS NEARLY 600**

At a time when the nation is gripped by divisiveness and intolerance for those who differ from us is worn by many like a badge of courage, nearly 600 people from all walks of life came together for the Third Annual Union County Day of Prayer, held October 6 at The Parish Community of St. Helen in Westfield.

"Day of Prayer and Reflection: Honoring People of All Faith Communities" drew speakers and readers from the Christian, Jewish, Muslim, Hindu and Sikh faiths. They were joined by people of all races and nationalities, as well as more than 100 people with disabilities. The event featured prayers, meditations and songs.

The Annual Union County Day of Prayer is planned and orchestrated each year by the Union County Interfaith Coordinating Council, an organization comprising interfaith congregations and community-based nonprofits, including Community Access Unlimited (CAU). The council promotes inclusion of all people within the community and creates a clearing house of faith-based, nonprofit and government community services available to the public while bringing greater awareness of these services to the wider community, according to Sid Blanchard, CAU executive director.

"In these times when families are being rendered asunder, when communities are being torn apart, when someone who is different is being rejected, it is essential to come together," Blanchard said.

Rabbi Joel Abraham of the Temple Sholom in Scotch Plains said, "I think it's important to stand

with people of other faiths whenever possible. Especially now when there is a force of division...we want to reach across the pew and see how we are more alike than different yet also celebrate the ways we are different."

Reverend Cynthia Cochran-Carney of the Willow Grove Presbyterian Church in Scotch Plains, said, "There are many misunderstandings in our country about different faith groups, many stereotypes. I want to promote the vision we are all called by God and need to respect each other."

The Venerable Klint Kaevalin from the Buddhist Dhammakaya Meditation Center in Fanwood, said, "It's nice when we can come together and share peace and have a true commonality that we want to have goodness in the world."

Dr. Mohammad Ali Chaudry of the Islamic Society of Basking Ridge said, "Interfaith cooperation is critical for not only the Muslim community but all communities. I've been talking about how to confront and counter bigotry. I will know I am making a difference when I see a Muslim say something hateful about another group and another Muslim stand up and say, 'That's not right.' When a Jew says something hateful and another Jew says, 'That's not right.' And a Christian and so on."

Chaudry encouraged everyone in attendance to sign a pledge to "stand up for the other" that reads: "While interacting with members of my own faith or ethnic community, or with others, if I hear hateful comments from anyone about members of any other community, I pledge to

stand up for the other and challenge bigotry in any form." The pledge form is available online at www.standupfortheother.org.

"If you hear something hateful and bigoted, if you don't speak out they'll think you agree with them," Chaudry said. "If we can all take enough of a stand speaking out that that's not right, we can make a difference."




