

ELIZ POLICE RANK 1ST IN STATE

Even with all the foibles that come with being a big city, Elizabeth maintains a Epolice force second to none. It is difficult to quantify the quality of police officers but the NJ State Lieutenant test is one indication of how accomplished the men and women of EPD are. Five finished in the top seven, Sgt. Jim Sacca was number one.

Every three years the State of New Jersey's Department of Personnel issues a test to determine a police officer's eligibility for the rank of Lieutenant. The test is available to sergeants' statewide. Approximately 500 officers take the grueling test and then are ranked according to their scores. Sgt. Giacumo (Jim) Sacca of the Elizabeth Police Department finished first in the state with a score of 89.090.

This is a considerable accomplishment not only for Sacca but also for the department that he represents, 365 officers in all. Not only did Sacca score high but his fellow officers did extremely well also. The top five scores in Elizabeth would have been the number one score in any other town in New Jersey but two.

Twenty-one Elizabeth sergeants passed the test; the lowest score being 82.790, still a formidable score where 70 is passing. The success of the Elizabeth police officers this year is not an aberration either. They are consistently in the top ten finishers in the various tests administered by the state.

The material on the test is highly technical. The sergeants must know New Jersey

Criminal Code (title 2c), Motor Vehicle Code (title 39), NJ Case Law, the Attorney General Guidelines, Juvenile Law (title 40a), Child Protection Laws (title 9), in addition to a management curriculum. The scope of the material goes to show the level of studying and preparation that the officers applied to their vocation. It shows a level of dedication to their jobs above what is required. Though there are training programs, the achievements are due in large part to personal conviction and fortitude. There is no better example of this than Sgt. Sacca. Jim was born and raised in the Peterstown section of Elizabeth, NJ and for as far back as he could remember he wanted to be a police officer.

His father John immigrated to America from S'eufamia, Calabria, Italy, in 1963. He left his wife Maria and their four children for six months until he could raise enough money to pay their way. In two years time he was able to purchase the home he was living in. Jim and Maria had two more children. Born in 1972, Jim was the youngest. He felt that being a police officer was a way to give back to the community and he would have a direct effect on keeping the city he loved

safe and make it a good place for his family to live.

An amazing aspect of Jim's achievement is that he has no advanced degrees. He went to St Anthony's grammar school, across the street from his home on Third Avenue, and he graduated from Elizabeth High School. Like almost all the Sacca clan, after high school he went to work for his Uncle Jim who had a butcher shop next door. All along he dreamed of being on the police force and he never stopped studying. His father was a mason for the City of Elizabeth, both his parents taught themselves how to speak English and stressed to their children the virtues of a good education and work ethic. Jim is also bilingual.

Jim continued to study, took a few college classes, and when he was ready,



enrolled in the police academy. He was sworn in and started his rookie year in 1995. Sacca spent four years patrolling midnights. In 1999 he was assigned to plain cloths and in 2005 was promoted to sergeant. He finished second in Elizabeth on that test.

Sgt. Sacca has been a member of the Emergency Service Unit since 2000. It is an all-purpose S.W.A.T. team that performs the duties that fall outside of the regular patrol officers, like Hostage Rescue and Hazardous Waste Incidents. The team of 32 officers is required to maintain a level of physical and intellectual preparedness for this duty and it requires a lot of self-sacrifice.

Jim works full-time in emergency service and is now training others. The younger officers could not have a better teacher, coach or mentor. His favorite quote is by E.M. Kelly, "The difference between a boss and a leader is a boss says, 'Go!' -a leader says, 'Let's go!' As a leader Sgt. Sacca is ensuring that future Elizabeth officers will continue to rank as the best.



Editor's Opinion everybody has one - this is mine - by Joe Renna

The achievements of Sgt. Jim Sacca should be celebrated for several reasons. So much of the news is negative. It is then sensationalized even further for entertainment value. The bad guys are glorified to a point of being celebrities. Then the characters are imitated in movies and on television. It's bad enough that they enamor kids but adults are even worse. Jim won't be the subject of a "Movie of the Week," but at least he could make the cover of the Peterstown Newspaper.

The value to Jim's story is that it may inspire other kids to pursue the same career path. Kids who grew up not much different than he did, a son or daughter of immigrant parents of modest income and growing up in a city with many distractions. He is the role model that parents should hold up to their children.

I love to write about all types of accomplishments because you never know what story could put a spark in some youngster's eye. I especially like writing about those in arts and entertainment. The creative fields were so foreign to me when I was young. I didn't know any artists or writers. Those who did pursue creative careers naturally relocated. There were few movie studios or publishing companies around Peterstown.

There is one aspect of promoting the arts that gets in my craw. It's the counter action to promotion. Not the critic necessarily but the protester. The sanctimonious sloths who try to censor the work of an artist or writer because they don't approve of the content.

The HBO series the Sopranos is probably the best example of this issue. For some reason writing about organized crime using Italian-Americans as subjects is considered degrading to some. I've written about this topic before but it warrants revisiting because of a book that is reviewed in this issue of the newspaper, Men Without Redemption, on page 20.

I think writing a book is initself is a great accomplishment. The author, Nick Gallicchio, should be commended. 





DO YOU KNOW SOMEONE IN THE FAVOR FAMILY?

Lucia and Francisco Favato were not much different than their neighbors in the Peterstown section of Elizabeth, NJ at the turn of the 20th century, hard working Italian immigrants living the American dream and making a life for their children that was better than they had. In the hustle and bustle of the 21st century the subtly of this lifestyle is lost.

The concern for Lucia and Francisco was not themselves but their children and they lived not for the present but for the future. Though they were not famous or celebrated they made the most valuable contribution to the world, their family.

Frank Favato was born in Italy on September 12, 1874. In America his name morphed into Frank Favor. He married Lucia Ricardelli on October 13, 1891 in New York City.

The favors moved to Peterstown and lived at 629 4th Avenue. There they had 18 children in which they raised 13 at this address. All the children were raised in this house. Belonged to St. Anthony's Church. Frank Favor worked on the barges down the port of Elizabeth, planted a huge garden on South 5th Street and made homemade wine on his wine press that was cemented into the basement of the house.

It wasn't uncommon to have children numbering into double digits. In those days children were not considered a burden or a drain on one's life. They were the purpose for living.

Thought the surnames have changed through marriage the chances of knowing a decent of the Favors is high. For instance Gordy Coletti Sr. & Jr. are well known for their bowling accomplishments. Gordy Sr. was a pro bowler and Gordy Jr. is working on his 15th perfect game. Bowling is definitely in the Favor blood. Gordy Jr. use to have his pro shops and if you went into any of the local bowling alley's throughout the 50's still to this day, you could find the men and women of the Favor family bowling somewhere.

Gordy Coletti Sr. is married to Minnie Coletti who is one of the daughter's of Millie Favor. Wendy Soltis (daughter of Joyce Coletti/Favor) is very accomplished kick boxer and has won many titles. Carol Vollaro was once the mayor of Cranford. She is the daughter of Carrie (Caroline) Favor. The first born of Lucia & Frank Favor. Many have become business owners and professionals.

The original 18 Favor children did not graduate from high school, although all of their children,



grandchildren and so on have and went on to plus achieve college degrees on their way to becoming business owners.

Most of the original Favor children have lived well into there late 80's to there late 90's in relatively good health. Of course most them loved gardening and living well, traits shared by the children also. To date Frank and Lucia left a legacy of 268 descendants in which 32 that are living productive lives. What every positive contributions the following generations of Favors do can be attributed to Frank and Lucia.

Sgt. Jim Sacco runs the Elizabeth Chapter of the Police Unity Tour. He has been involved with the organization for four years. Police officer Patrick Montuore of Florham Park, NJ, started it in 1997 with hopes of raising awareness of police officers who have died in the line of duty and to honor their sacrifices.

Jim got involved with three other riders from Elizabeth and more joined in each year. Last year 15 Elizabeth police officers make the trek from Ground Zero in New York to Washington D.C., a 360 mile journey that takes several days. This year the tour leaves May 9th and arrives May 12th.

Sacca's favorite quotes from the Bible. Supreme Court Justice Antonin Scalia, one of Jim's role models, used it in a footnote in California v. Hodari to make a point that it is not necessarily unreasonable to stop a person who runs away in panic at the sight of a police officer. The secondary purpose of the tour is to raise funds for the National Law Enforcement Officer's Memorial and Museum. Eighteen riders participated in the first year of the tour and raised \$18,000. This past year over 1,000 members nationwide made the trip, raising \$1.15 million, bringing the total for donations to date \$4.35 million.





JOEY'S ITALIAN DELI GOES FULL CIRCLE

The story of Joey's Italian Deli is typical for Peterstown folks. It's a case where the apple doesn't fall from the tree, where kids follow in their parents footsteps, where parents help their children achieve their goals and where family is as much a part of the business plan as any other element of success.

On January 23, 2008 Joe LaPlaca and partner Lindsey Graca officially opened Joey's Italian Deli & Catering. The deli is located on St. Georges Avenue in Rahway inside Witty's Liquors. The deli is the result of the natural progression of events in Joe and Lindsey's lives that seems to fulfill a destiny.

Joe is the son of Patty LaPlaca who owned Kevin's Korner, on the corner of Palmer Street and Third Avenue, in the Peterstown section of Elizabeth, NJ from 1998 to 2004. Kevin's was one of the neighborhood's favorite corner stores going far back. Patty bought the store from her brother Kevin Dugan, who started a Boar's Head distribution business, Dugan Provisions. Kevin had owned it from 1987 to 1998. It was Jim's Corner, operated by Jim Samartino, prior to being Kevin's.

The closing of Kevin's ended an era for the family business. But as cream always rises to the top, Patty's customers knew she would resurface.

The deli in Witty's was one of Kevin's Boar's Head customers. The Deli was owned and operated by the Witty's but was not operating at its potential. Kevin envisioned what the deli would be in the hands of experienced food experts. Wheels were set in motion that brought Witty's together with Joe and Lindsey through Patty and Joey's Italian Deli was born.

The family ties do not end there for when she is not teaching Joe's sister pitch's in. Her boyfriend Paul Merlo is also a cook. Paul, who is the son of Lenny, a family friend from Peterstown, has been working for Dugan Provisions.

The family ties add an almost sentimental dimension to the business. As if the story wasn't enchanting enough Joe and Lindsey have their own heart-warming tale to tell.

Joe and Lindsey were high school sweet hearts, both graduated from Roselle Catholic in 2001. They attended Kean University together and both graduated in 2005. Julia ran the kitchen, famous for its prepared foods, for Mike Barone for many years. Like doing homework he would watch his mom and Mrs. Guiducci prepare and cook a wide variety of Italian dishes.

Joe had the opportunity to hone his cooking skills for real at DaVinci's Restaurant in Carteret owned by his friends, two brothers from the neighborhood, Pino



4 cups Milk 1/2 cup of Brown Sugar 1 tsp Cinnamon Crushed Nuts Pancake Syrup to taste

1) Mix all Bread, Sugar, Eggs, Pineapple, Vanilla, Heavy Cream, and Milk together in bowl.

2) Pour mixture into 13 x 15 greased pan.

3) Mix Brown Sugar, Cinnamon and Crushed nuts then sprinkle on top of mixture.

Nick Gallicchio takes a myriad of plots and interlaces them to construct a story of epic proportions. He shines light on the politics, allegiance, and crime in America's


