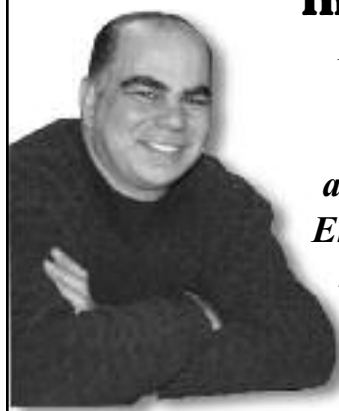

Mr. Hauer is no stranger to Long Hill Township and had performed here last season. His virtuosity and command of the piano repertoire is more than impressive. As a soloist, chamber musician, and collaborative pianist, Mr. Hauer hails from Appleton Wisconsin. Only 23 years old, he has already performed concertos with the Oberlin Orchestra, Fox Valley Symphony, Madison Symphony Orchestra, and Wisconsin Chamber Orchestra. Hauer is currently pursuing a Masters in Piano Performance with Eteri Andjaparidze at the NYU Steinhardt School of Music, where he holds a position as Adjunct Instructor of Piano. He is also a Summer Chamber Music Instructor at the Arthur Krempin School of Music in Appleton, WI. He completed his undergraduate studies at the Oberlin Conservatory with Professor Peter Takács on a full scholarship from the Miller Family Music Education Scholarship; at Oberlin, he was awarded the Junior Prize in Piano, named alternate winner in the Arthur Dann Piano Competition, and was winner of the Senior

Concerto Competition.

Cellist Jiafan Shi is currently completing her graduate studies at NYU with Marion Feldman, where she also serves as an adjunct instructor. She was the recipient of NYU Orchestral Scholarship and Talent Scholarship, and is the principle cellist of NYU symphony orchestra. Dedicated to both music performance and pedagogy, Jiafan worked as a professional cellist at the Shanghai Opera House (2010-2014), where she performed in more than 300 productions, including Turandot under Lorin Maazel and La Bohème under Daniel Oren. Prior to working at the Shanghai Opera House, Jiafan received her bachelor of art degree from Tongji University. She was a recipient of the National Scholarship, the highest awarded to Chinese university students.

ATTORNEY SETTLES HOME EXPLOSION LITIGATION FOR \$975,000.00

Attorney David C. Bendush announced settlement of a lawsuit arising from a home explosion in Hunterdon County in September of 2014. The blast was caused by a contractor who was converting the home of his clients, from oil to natural gas. Mr. Bendush litigated the liability issues aggressively, and attained the unusual result of summary judgment for plaintiff. The defense had little choice but to settle quickly and on favorable terms, in order to avoid a trial.

KNOW THE BEAR FACTS - BLACK BEARS IN NEW JERSEY BEAR SAFETY TIPS

NJ Department of Environmental Protection Division of Fish and Wildlife

Black bears by nature tend to be wary of people. However, if you encounter a black bear in your neighborhood or outdoors, follow these common-sense safety tips.

- Never feed or approach a bear!
- Remain calm if you encounter a bear. Do not run from it. Make the bear aware of your presence by speaking in an assertive voice, singing, clapping your hands, or making other noises.
- Make sure the bear has an escape route.
- If a bear enters your home, provide it with an escape route by propping all doors open.
- Avoid direct eye contact, which may be perceived by a bear as a challenge. Never run from a bear. Instead, slowly back away.
- To scare the bear away, make loud noises by yelling, banging pots and pans or using an airhorn. Make yourself look as big as possible by waving your arms. If you are with someone else, stand close together with your arms raised above your head.
- The bear may utter a series of huffs, make popping jaw sounds by snapping its jaws and swat the ground. These are warning signs that you are too close. Slowly back away, avoid direct eye contact and do not run.
- If a bear stands on its hind legs or moves closer, it may be trying to get a better view or detect



scents in the air. It is usually not a threatening behavior.

- Black bears will sometimes "bluff charge" when cornered, threatened or attempting to steal food. Stand your ground, avoid direct eye contact, then slowly back away and do not run.
- If the bear does not leave, move to a secure area.
- Report black bear damage or nuisance behavior to the DEP's 24-hour, toll-free hotline at 1-877-WARN DEP (1-877-927-6337).
- Families who live in areas frequented by black bears should have a "Bear Plan" in place for children, with an escape route and planned use of whistles and air horns.
- Black bear attacks are extremely rare. If a black bear does attack, fight back!
