LPD SERGEANT PROMOTION CEREMONY

Department gathered with family and friends to celebrate the promotion of three officers to the rank of Sergeant. The promotions of Kenneth Mikolajczyk, Martin Jedrzejewski, and Joseph Rivera were approved unanimously at the November City Council Meeting.

Michael Babulski, president of the Linden Police Superior Officer Association, said he was pleased to see continued progress in the Police Department "We thank Mayor Armstead and the City Council for their support in bringing our department back from years of neglect. The guidance and leadership shown by Chief Parham during this process has been instrumental."

Kenneth Mikolajczyk joined the Linden Police Department in January 1993. He worked in the Patrol Division for about six years. In 1999 he was assigned to the Narcotics Bureau, where he participated in over 1000 investigations before he was transferred to the Criminal Investigations Bureau in 2012. In 2016 Det. Mikolajczyk was selected as Officer of the Year for his work as lead investigator in the shooting and subsequent homicide of Linden resident Tyrita Julius.

Martin Jedrzejewski joined the Linden Police


On December 5th the Linden Police Department in July 2005. He served with distinction in the Patrol Division until his assignment to the Narcotics Bureau in January 2015. Within his first year he led a six month, multi-jurisdictional investigation that dismantled heroin mills in both Linden and Carteret that resulted in eight arrests, the recovery of two guns, raw and packaged heroin with a street value of over \$1,000,000, and approximately \$240,000 in cash.

> Joseph Rivera joined the Linden Police Department in January 2009. He has worked in the Patrol Division, and in March 2016 was chosen as a Field Training Officer. He was tasked with mentoring and training officers following their graduation from the Police Academy.

"The vision the Mayor, City Council and I have of improving the safety of the citizens of Linden is closer to being realized, as today we promote three highly decorated police officers to the rank of Sergeant" said Chief Jonathan Parham. "Today's promotions demonstrate the unified effort between city government and the police department, and brings us closer to reaching our goals of safer streets, and safer citizens.



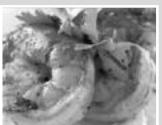

MOURNING DOVES (PART ONE)

WINTER BACKYARD BIRD FEEDING

Mourning doves are the most successful wild dove in North America, with a range from Alaska, Canada, Maine and as far south as Panama.

Although most Mourning doves migrate south during the winter months, many stay in our area where they depend on back yard bird feeders for survival

Mourning doves feed on a vast assortment of seeds including weed seeds which makes it a valuable ally of farmers and gardeners. If you keep your bird feeders stocked Mourning doves will stay close, eating off the ground (gleaning) under feeders which helps keep that area clean.

Snow and ice make it difficult for these birds to scratch up seed, but there are a few things that you can do to help them. During the snowfall sprinkle seed on top to keep food in reach. If possible flatten an area and sprinkle the seed on that area. After a big storm I put cardboard on top of the snow and sprinkle the seed on top of that. I feed Mourning doves millet which is their favorite seed and black-oil sunflower seed because it is high in protein.

Mourning doves also utilize a heated birdbath for drinking water if you can provide it.

Also known as 'Turtle Doves', Mourning doves are medium size birds around 5 to 6 ounces, with brown pointed wings and tail, white and black markings and a crescent on its neck. Males have blue and pink highlights on the head and around

their eyes. The pointed falcon like wings give them the ability to reach speeds of 40 to 55 miles per hour. Mourning doves are related to the now extinct 'Passenger doves' used in wartime to deliver messages.

During takeoff their flapping wings make a loud whirling sound and their strong feet enable then to push off the ground quickly. The call from the male is a hollow mournful coah, cooo, cooo.

Habitat is open farmlands, towns, roadsides, open grasslands and scrubs. I'll provide more information on Mourning doves mating and raising their young in the spring.

NEW VIRTUAL BLOCK WATCH PROGRAM TO BE UNVEILED IN LINDEN

Mayor Derek Armstead announced on December 7th his new initiative with the support of the Linden Police Department, that the City of Linden will be unveiling their Virtual Block Watch Program.

Mayor Derek Armstead said, "This virtual block watch will bring residents and business owners together in an attempt to prevent crime and improve the quality of life in our community. It is what one might call the 21st Century Neighborhood Block Watch". The Mayor went on to say, "the virtual block watch is an attempt to answer, "How do we come up with another solution to ensure that we are capable of protecting our community and assist the police department in their efforts to keep us safe."

Chief Jonathan Parham said, "In a virtual block watch, police partner with businesses, community groups and concerned residents to acquire video surveillance involving crime, and having access to these cameras will aid in investigation purposes." The Chief added, "Having cameras in our neighborhoods and downtown area will help relieve all day canvassing efforts that officers have to do when

investigating a crime. This initiative will help the police connect with the community and reach out to residents working proactively helping our department to help better protect and serve the residents and businesses."

By registering your camera you can directly contribute to the safety of our community by making it an undesirable target for criminals. If you register you are advising Law Enforcement that a particular area is under video surveillance. Registration does not imply consent, and law enforcement will not view your video without your permission. Should a crime occur nearby, a police representative will contact you and request to view the video.

Linden residents and businesses who already have cameras can register their cameras with the Linden Police Department either online or by submitting a registration form, in person to Linden Police Headquarters. The form will be located on the city website and can be downloaded.

Free cameras will be distributed on a first come first serve basis to qualified senior citizens as part of the initial pilot program.

HAWK RISE SANCTUARY AUDUBON PROGRAMS

The Hawk Rise Sanctuary is located on Range Road in Linden, NJ and is open to the public daily from dawn until dusk. The city-owned natural resource and wetland complex has long been recognized by numerous Federal, State and non-governmental organizations as an important environmental feature in the Rahway River and Arthur Kill watersheds. Please note dogs are not allowed on the trails.

Under the stewardship of the New Jersey Audubon Society, a full suite of natural history programs for families and adults are offered, many are free.

In 2012 the City transformed their closed landfill and adjacent property into a wildlife and passive recreational setting –a place for the public to visit and walk trails through the Hawk Rise forest and to enjoy overlooks of the Rahway River. Designed to encourage hiking, bird watching and nature appreciation, Hawk Rise has nearly a mile and a half of elevated walkways and an observation deck to enjoy the panoramic view of the Rahway River. The trails are equipped with interpretive signage to provide visitors with habitat descriptions and information regarding the 123 species of birds and other wildlife that have been encountered in the area.

Hawk Rise also represents an opportunity to reach youths of all ages to infuse an appreciation and commitment to ecological restoration, enhancement and preservation. The City of Linden has worked with the Linden Public Schools to integrate the Sanctuary with the Science curriculum as well as to provide professional development for teachers who will be taking groups of students to Hawk Rise for ecological studies. The first two phases of the Sanctuary were constructed with Green Acres grant monies, and assistance from local corporations.



Hawk Rise Great Backyard Bird Count - Saturday, February 18, 10:30 a.m. to Noon

This is the weekend of the Great Backyard Bird Count (GBBC) an annual, national citizenscience event sponsored by Cornell University and the National Audubon Society. Learn how to identify common suburban birds and then take a hike to see who is staying at Hawk Rise. After we get some practice we will officially participate in the GBBC and log our data! This program is intended for birders of all ages and ability; loaner binoculars will be available. Dress warmly and be prepared to walk in snow or mud.


