



BLOOD RESERVES CHALLENGED BY PATIENT DEMAND

O-Negative Blood a Constant Challenge

New Jersey Blood Services, a division of New Scotch Plains Donor Center, 2279 South Ave, York Blood Center (NYBC) is asking for help to maintain an adequate supply of all blood types, but especially O-negative - the "universal" blood which can be transfused into anyone in an emergency. In addition, hundreds of additional blood drives need to be scheduled to meet projected hospital demand. Current inventory of several blood types is running below the desired target level.

"It's simple: hospital patient demand for blood and schedule blood drives," said NYBC Executive Director of Donor Recruitment Andrea Cefarelli. "There are always reasons but we have to overcome that for the sake of hospital patients who need us."

"This is one of the toughest times of the year," Cefarelli added. "We're asking for our dedicated supporters to roll up their sleeves to make sure we're able to provide our hospital partners with whatever they need to take care of their patients."

Blood products have a short shelf life – from five to 42 days, so constant replenishment is necessary. Each and every day there are patients who depend on the transfusion of red blood cells, platelets and plasma to stay alive. But blood and blood products can't be manufactured. They can only come from volunteer blood donors who take an hour to attend a blood drive or visit a donor

Eligible donors include those people at least age 16 (with parental permission or consent), who weigh a minimum of 110 pounds, are in good health and meet all Food & Drug Administration and NY or NJ State Department of Health donor criteria. People over 75 may donate with a doctor's note.

2016 NATIONAL MERIT SEMIFINALISTS

According to NMSC, about 90 percent of this year's Semifinalists are expected to be eventually named Finalists. The competition continues for this year's Semifinalists, with students required to submit a detailed application including academic record, records of school and community activity participation, employment records, lists of other honors and awards won, and indications of leadership skills. They must also take the SAT.

Finalists are vying for about 2,500 National Merit Scholarships, as well as about 1,000 scholarships awarded by businesses and corporations and some 4,000 scholarships from colleges and universities to students attending their colleges and universities.


