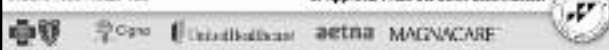

Imagine, Inc., a free year-round NJ grief support center, held an open house on Wednesday February 22nd, to welcome the community to their new facility located at 244 Sheffield St. in Mountainside, NJ.

"Moving into this new space will allow us to double the number of children and families we are able to serve in the years to come," said Mary Robinson, Executive Director and Founder of Imagine, A Center for Coping with Loss. teens develop healthy coping skills and foster resiliency and emotional well-being for all those who grieve.

Imagine was made possible through the vision and financial support of Dr. Gerald Glasser in 2011 who wanted to ensure there was grief support available for children and families in his beloved community of Westfield and surrounding towns. The Glasser Foundation has continued to provide generous annual financial support to Imagine.

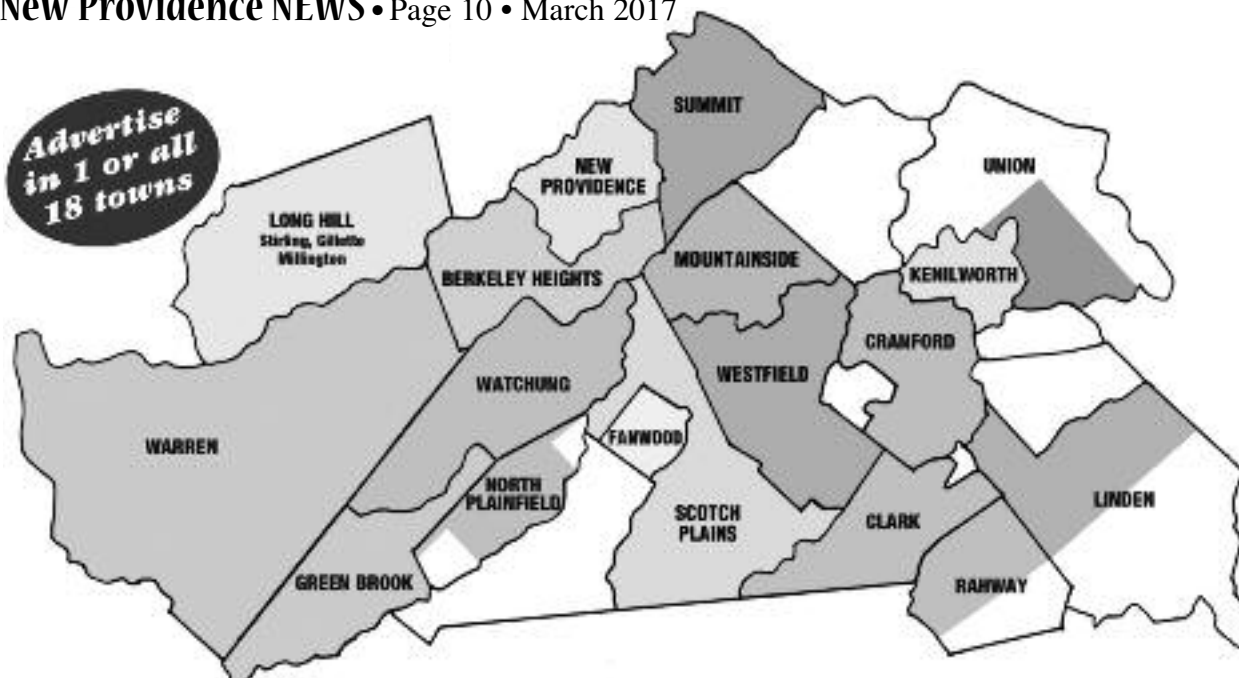
