## LOVE BLOSSOMS IN "OUR TOWN"

Although still months and a few snowstorms away, Spring is in full bloom in Rahway High School's theater department thanks to the creative efforts of Theater Director Jensyn Modero. Beginning with her successful production of Thornton Wilder's "Our Town" which premiered on December 2, 2016 at Hamilton Stage, 'Ms. Mo' has fashioned a season of student performances based in great part "on people connecting with other people." The most recent was her Theater I students' presentation February 8 of "Check, Please" during Cabaret Night at RHS. Modero boasts that the performance went "better than planned" and that the audience "enthusiastically connected to the contemporary style of the writing."

'Ms. Mo's' choice of theme is firmly rooted in her belief that "there is a need for people to feel wanted and connected to others in today's world where technology alienates rather than unites." Variations on this theme are further explored as she provides her Theater II students, as part of a Spring project, with a special opportunity to design, produce and direct, as well as act in, a trio of plays. Students will display their versatile theatrical talents on May 19 and 20 at 7:00 in a Showcase Performance at RHS when they present abridged versions of "Steel Magnolias", "Barefoot In The Park" and "Penguin Tango." further support and guide the students in their efforts Mr. Stephen Svoboda, playwright of "Penguin Tango", has offered to come and work directly with the students on preparing for the world premier high school performance of his play right here in 'our town', Rahway.

In preparation for their assuming all the creative roles which comprise the total theatrical experience, students are currently being given the opportunity to challenge their imaginations through the creation of their own original plays. Once again, their teacher has secured the talents of yet another expert in his field, Playwright / Actor / Director Jim Ligon of Writer's Theater of New Jersey, to assist them in putting their ideas down on paper. Mr. Ligon has graciously offered his services for a four day 'residency' at the high school to work with the students as they essay the role of playwrights.

After completing their first two classes under Mr. Ligon's guidance, students were in agreement that his help was, at the very least, invaluable! He continues, "When we talk about what makes them angry or sad or happy, what moves them, where their curiosity lies, the answers are as unique and individual as they are, and it empowers them to express themselves in ways they've not considered before."

Ms. Modero and her Theater II class proudly invite the entire Rahway community to join them at Hamilton Stage on March 16, 2017 at 7:00 for a staged reading of students' original plays performed by professional actors! The love the students have for their craft will be obvious to all who share in the evening's performance, a perfect complement to this season's theme!

## RAHWAY PUBLIC SCHOOLS AWARDED SUSTAINABILITY GRANTS

Sustainable Jersey for Schools and the New Jersey Education Association (NJEA) announced that all six Rahway Public District Schools have been awarded a Sustainable Jersey for Schools capacity-building grant. The six \$2,000 grants (\$12,000 total) are intended to assist the school green teams as they lead and coordinate sustainability activities.

# CITY OFFICES WERE HOUSED IN MANY LOCATIONS UNTIL 1982

From the time of our city's incorporation (1858), city offices had been housed in a variety of buildings wherever and whenever office space became available. Although the need for a city hall building was discussed many times over the next 130 years, a structure purposely built as a city hall did not become a reality until 1982. The movement of city hall offices from one location to another is an interesting story and is part of Rahway's history.

To begin, one must go back to March 12, 1858, when the New Jersey State Legislature granted incorporation papers to the City of Rahway. A month later, on April 19, the citizens of Rahway went to the polls and elected city officials. Edward R. Rogers was elected to serve as the first mayor. The initial meetings of council were held in Washington Hall, an old, three-story building that was built before the Revolutionary War. It was located on Main Street just south of the corner of Monroe. How long the council met in Washington Hall or if any city offices were ever located there is not documented.

The first building to actually be referred to as "city hall" was another old building (circa 1760) located on the corner of Main and Bridge Streets. City officials would meet at this site until 1867. Forty-five years later, in 1912, the structure was razed to make way for the elevation of the railroad tracks.

In 1867, a brand new three-story structure was being built on the corner of Main and Monroe to serve as the new home of the Rahway Savings Institution, and city officials were offered the opportunity to move into office space on the second floor. The Rahway Savings building would serve the city well, but in 1912 discussions began concerning the issue of raising funds to build a new city hall. Rahway's mayor at the time, Thomas A. Fyffe, had stated, "The need for a city hall is acknowledged by all and the lack of one is a matter to be deplored." The wheels of government turn slowly, however, and by the time adequate property became available, the country was engaged in World War I, upsetting the financial resources available to the city. At the same time, conditions in the bank were becoming cramped and rent was high, so a search was made for a new home. City officials did not have to look far. Right next door to the bank was a recently vacated dry goods store that had been owned by the Gries brothers. In early 1918, the brothers had moved to larger quarters on Cherry Street making their former location available. City offices were immediately moved in and would remain there until 1932.

Mayor Adolph Ulbrich, in his State of the City Address given in January, 1930, advocated plans for a city hall that would include police and fire departments. Everyone on council knew the plan had merit, but they also realized "This was not the time." The country was in the throes of the Depression and Rahway was suffering through its own period of financial crisis. In 1932 a development took place that would once again influence the relocation of city offices. The Citizens' National Bank, which had been located in the Woodruff Building on the corner of Irving and Lewis merged with their neighbors from across the street, the Rahway National Bank. The vacated Citizen's Bank was newer, had more room and also housed a large safe which would be ideal for securing city records. City offices quickly moved into the Woodruff Building, their 5th home. It wasn't the home everyone dreamed of, but it would suffice until the financial picture changed. The building would serve as city hall for the next seven years.

By 1940, Mayor John E. Barger formed a committee to meet with the Board of Education to decide the fate of the old high school building on Campbell Street. The school, built in 1909, was to be vacated after June as

classes would be moving into a brand new high school on Madison Avenue. The move to Campbell Street seemed logical and prudent. Walls were cut through and partitions put in place changing former classrooms into department offices. The auditorium would serve as council chambers. The police department would be moved into the six room annex directly behind the building. By October, the city offices were moving into the former school.

The new home served the community well, but it was an older building and within ten years maintenance bills began to mount. It was estimated that modernization of the interior and structural needs to the exterior could reach \$25,000. By 1958, the centennial year of the city, a master plan for the city was drawn up that called for a new building that would include a city hall, a police department, an auditorium that would include recreational facilities, a library, and a public works garage. It was quite prophetic that the proposed site was listed as the corner of Main Street and Milton Avenue, just opposite the Methodist Church.

The city now had a master plan, but there would be little serious discussion concerning a "Civic Center" or even a new city hall until the late 1960s. In the election of 1969, a new mayor, Daniel L. Martin, was elected who strongly believed the city had to have new facilities, including a new city hall, police department, and fire headquarters. Considering the history of this topic over the past 110 years, the path forward would not be easy. In the period from late 1974 through early 1979, over thirty votes were taken by council on issues involving the new complex. Added to the debates in council, the Rahway Taxpayers Association opposed the project and petitioned against it. When the smoke cleared, however, the project went forward and ground was broken on April 28, 1979 ending 122 years of dreaming, debating, and delaying. A formal dedication was held on Saturday, June 26, 1982, finally giving the citizens of Rahway an actual city hall/police department complex of which they could point to with pride.

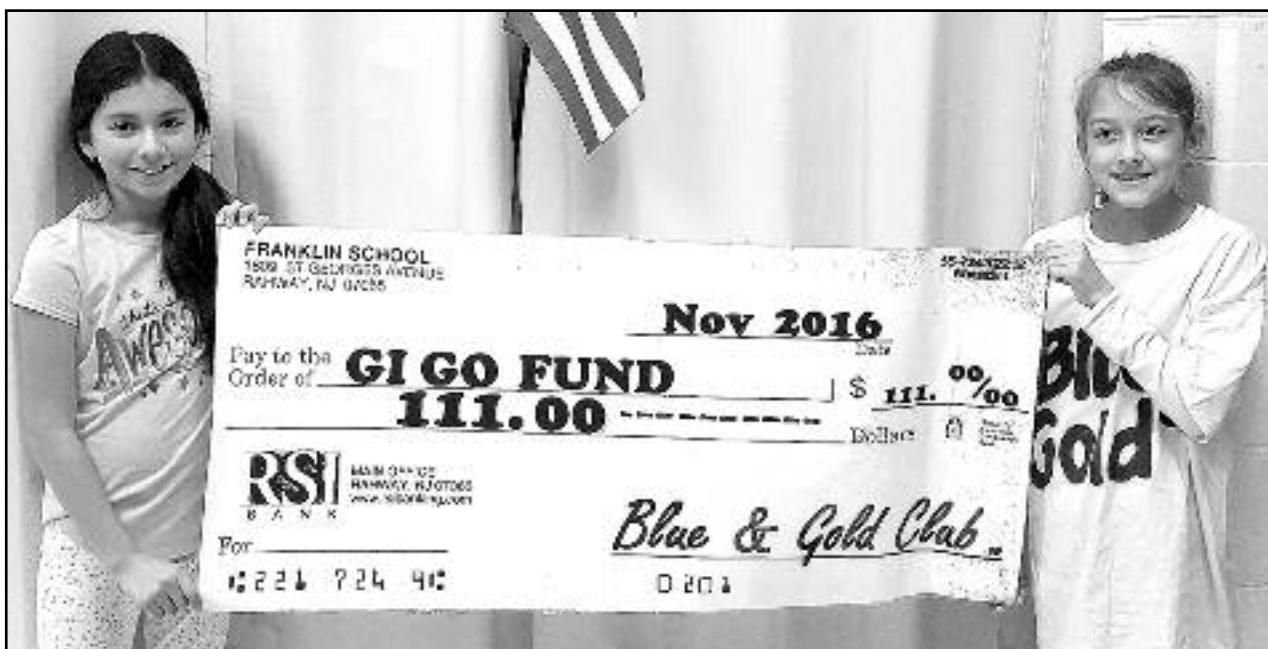

## LITTLE RED HATS WARM HEARTS IN A BIG WAY AT TRINITAS

Trinitas Regional Medical Center is joining the American Heart Association's Little Hats, Big Hearts program to raise awareness of family heart health and congenital heart defects, the most common type of birth defect in the country. The campaign coincides with Congenital Heart Defect Awareness Week in February, and aims to empower new moms to take charge of their own wellbeing while starting a healthy lifestyle for the entire family.

As part of the Little Hats, Big Hearts program, babies born at Trinitas during the week of February 7 received a red knitted or crocheted hat, and a kit full of heart-healthy information for mom and baby. The kit includes tips on raising healthy children, heart-healthy workouts that can be done at home, recipes, and information on congenital heart defects.

"More than 40,000 infants are diagnosed with congenital heart disease each year. At Trinitas all of our newborns receive a critical congenital

heart disease screening before they go home, but some heart defects don't become known until the child is months or years old," states Gary S. Horan, FACHE, President & CEO of TRMC. "This is why we are so pleased to be part of a program that educates parents on congenital heart disease and informs them of symptoms they should look out for as their child ages."

Trinitas distributed nearly 100 kits during Congenital Heart Defect Awareness Week. Congenital heart defects are structural problems with the heart present at birth. They result when a mishap occurs during heart development soon after conception and often before the mother is aware that she is pregnant. Defects range in severity from simple problems, such as "holes" between chambers of the heart, to very severe malformations, such as complete absence of one or more of the heart's chambers or valves. According to the American Heart Association, it's possible to fix most congenital heart defects and

there are an estimated 2 million CHD survivors in the United States.

Trinitas maintains a full-service cardiac facility as well as facilities for the intensive nursing care of patients with cardiac disease. ## AFRICAN VIOLETS

African Violets have long been the most popular flowering houseplants in the country and will continue to maintain this distinction far into the future. African Violets are not actually violets but are a genus (species) "Saintpaulia" related to Gloxinia, originally from Kenya and Tanzania, Africa.

One reason for its popularity is its ability to flower in indirect light and easy care. African violets are short plants with rounded or slightly pointed leaves with flower stalks emerging from the center. Flower colors range from white, pink, red, purple and blue with a yellow center. There is also a creeping variety which is less well known. Flowers have five single petals although now double flower are available as well as fringed and multi-colors varieties which seem to be created every day. Even variegated leaves of white and green can easily be found.

The abundant flowers bloom well with indirect sunlight all year long which help make African violets as popular as they are. They also prefer modern indoor temperatures of around sixty five degrees which is ideal. Most houseplants prefer cooler temps at night. Additionally a fully mature plant only requires a three to six inch pot making them ideal for window ledges, shelves or coffee tables. All these traits make African violets perfect flowering houseplants plant for almost everywhere in an apartment or house with enough indirect or good artificial light.

Considered an easy to care for plant, it is important to remember that African violets come from a warm climate. Water them with room

temperature water. Cold water causes yellow spotting on the leaves. Also avoid wetting the leaves when watering. Watering plants from the bottom is a good practice and let them dry out between watering. Overwatering can cause root rot, the most common cause of death of all houseplants. Also avoid drafts. Move away from cold drafty windows and air conditioners.

Easy and fun to propagate, you can take a leaf with the stem from the center of the plant and root it in water or potting soil. The outer leaves are too thick and do not root easily. Once rooted African violets grow quickly to flowering size. Off shoots from the main plant are best removed and to its own pot.

Requiring a rich soil mixture, you can purchase African violet soil premixed or you can blend your own, but they will not grow well in regular potting mix.

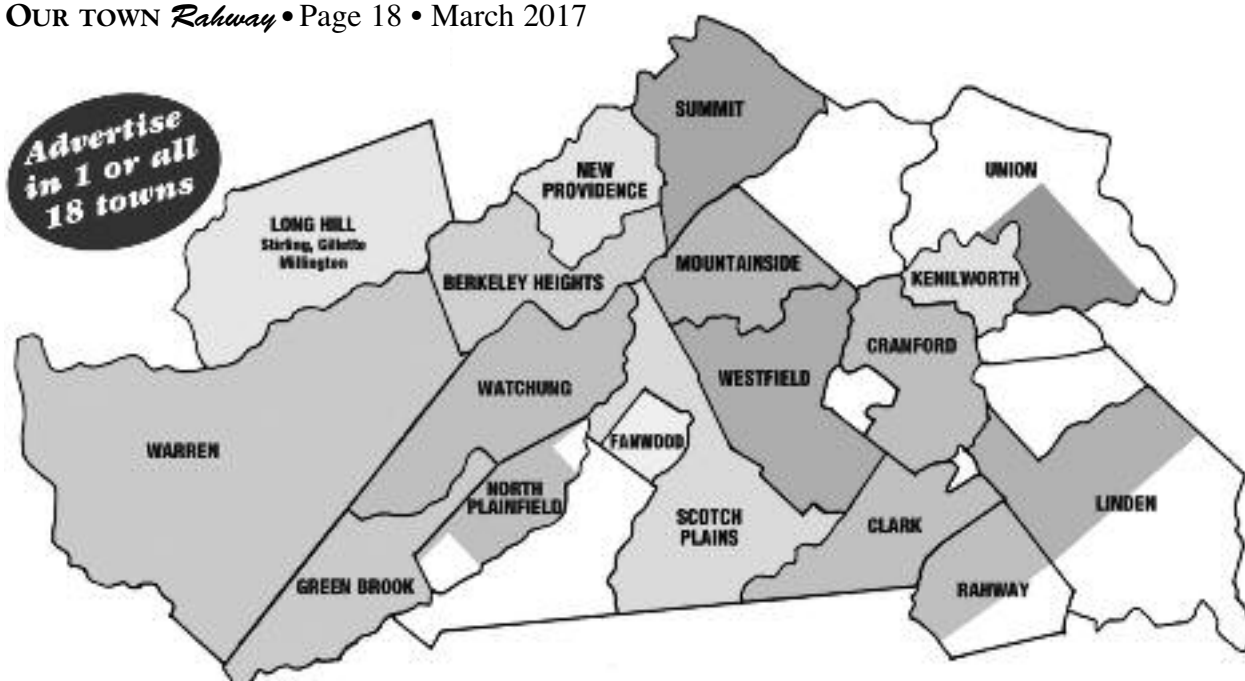

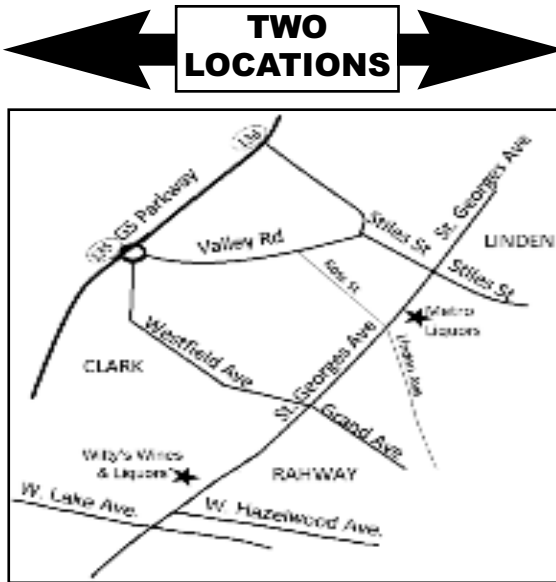

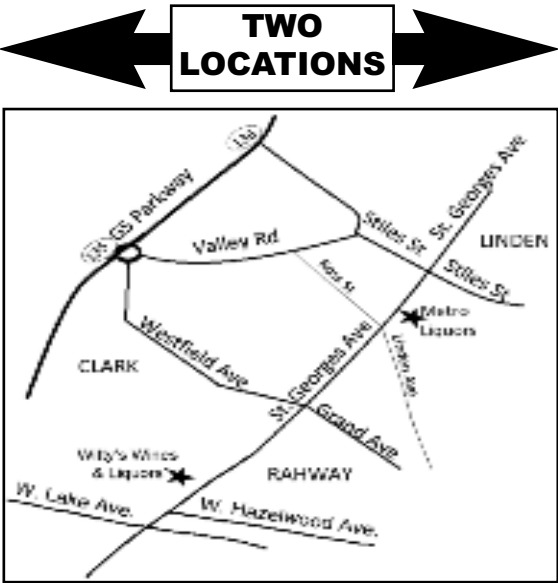
