HIGH SCHOOL REPERTORY THEATRE PRESENTS BYE BYE BIRDIE


The SPFHS Repertory Theatre is proud to present this year's production of Broadway's hit musical Bye Bye Birdie. Performances will be held on Friday, March 10, Saturday, March 11, Thursday, March 16, Friday, March 17 and Saturday, March 18 at 7:30 pm and Sunday, March 12 at 2 pm. All shows take place at Scotch Plains-Fanwood High School, 667 Westfield Road, Scotch Plains.

This classic musical set in the late 1950s features rock and roll star Conrad Birdie, an Elvis Presley type, at a time when he's at the top of the charts and drafted to the US Army. Birdie's manager and songwriter, Albert Peterson, and his longtime love, Rose Alvarez hatch a publicity stunt to help sell Birdie's new song, "One Last Kiss" and save their business from going under. They arrange for Conrad Birdie to give "one last kiss" on national television to Birdie superfan Kim MacAfee, a teen from small-town Sweet Apple, Ohio, at Birdie's farewell performance on the "Ed Sullivan Show." When Birdie and his team arrive in wholesome Sweet Apple everyone is abuzz, Kim's boyfriend, Hugo, is quite jealous and both merriment and chaos ensue.

The cast features a total of 53 students, 5 of whom are seniors and is under the direction of Mrs. Courtney Nemec, Director, SPFHS Repertory Theatre, a 5th grade teacher at Park Middle School and Mrs. Jan Allen, SPFHS Choral Director, SPFHS Repertory Theatre Music Director and Producer. The show has a large stage crew and importantly, features a pit band as well.

According to Allen, "The staff are very excited to present this classic show, Bye Bye Birdie, to the local community and beyond. The cast has been working tirelessly to put together a delightful on-stage performance, and all of the other off-stage components, with the commitment of many other students, are coming together in an equally exciting way."

HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS STUDY ABROAD IN ITALY

Seventeen junior and senior Italian language students at Scotch Plains-Fanwood High School recently embarked on the adventure of a lifetime when they participated in an academic-cultural exchange with the high school Liceo Statale-Vito Capialbi located in Vibo Valentia, Italy.

This authentic experience, which was organized by high school Italian teachers Mrs. Giuseppina Della Pietra and Mr. Antonio Gaetano, was unique in that it took place in the southwestern region of Calabria, an area not typically frequented by American tourists, and an area in which few people spoke English.

Students, therefore, were required to apply their Italian language skills to communicate with their host families, educators and community members during their nine-day stay, while also forging memorable bonds with their Italian peers and reaping the educational benefits of linguistic and cultural immersion.

In the process, our students visited artistically and historically rich sites in the scenic cities of Vibo, Scilla, Pizzo, and Reggio in Calabria, as well as Monreale, Palermo and Cefalu on the island of Sicily.

While expanding cultural horizons, the students were treated to foods that expanded gastronomic palettes as well. The culinary adventures, however, were a small clip in the larger picture of local hospitality. Indeed, the SPF group was warmly greeted at many turns by school officials, mayors, journalists and curators. Additionally, the program nurtured pedagogical discourse among educators on both sides of the Atlantic.

Time was utilized to share best practices regarding scope and sequence, methodology, and use of human and physical resources.

POLICE JOIN "PROJECT MEDICINE DROP"

Departments recently announced that they have joined the New Jersey Attorney General's "Project Medicine Drop" initiative, and have installed Project Medicine Drop boxes at both police headquarters. Iit easier and more convenient than ever for Fanwood and Scotch Plains residents to take an active role in the fight against the nationwide epidemic of opiate and heroin abuse, which often is fueled by the abuse of prescription painkiller.

"Project Medicine Drop" is a natural addition to our commitment to help improve the public safety and quality of life in both communities. It will encourage our residents to be fully aware of the potential for abuse presented by otherwise beneficial medications," Fanwood and Scotch Plains Chiefs Trigo and Conley. The department's new Project Medicine Drop Boxes are located at Fanwood Police Department 75 North Martine Avenue, Scotch Plains Police Department 430 Park Avenue. Residents may visit either police department at any time, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year, to dispose of their unused or excess medications.

Both Chiefs want to thank the Scotch Plains –

Fanwood and Scotch Plains Police Fanwood Municipal Alliance Committee and Prevention Links for their support and purchase of both drop boxes.

> Through this initiative, the State Division of Consumer Affairs installs secure "prescription drug drop boxes" at police departments, sheriff's offices and State Police barracks across New Jersey, allowing citizens to safely dispose of their unused, excess, or expired prescription medications.

> Members of the public are invited to visit the Project Medicine Drop sites and drop off any unused prescription medications anonymously and with no questions asked. Most Project Medicine Drop sites make this service available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week 365 days a year.

> By giving New Jerseyans a safe and secure method to dispose of unneeded medications, Project Medicine Drop helps prevent the abuse of these drugs. This initiative also protects New Jersey's environment by keeping these drugs out of landfills and out of the water supply.

LOCAL QUILTER AND EDUCATOR FEATURED AT 34TH ANNUAL QUILT SHOW

"Anything Goes" the quilts of Elsa Gail Hahn will be showcased at the Harvest Quilters of Central NJ's 34th annual quilt show on Saturday, March 25, 2017 at Willow Grove Presbyterian Church, Scotch Plains, NJ from 8am to 5pm.

Ms. Hahn's whimsical one-of-a-kind creations defy what is typically thought of as a quilt. Art quilts and wall hangings dominate her work, which spans 12 years of exploration in the fiber arts. An original Orca whale study on silk, inspired by a trip to the San Juan Islands, will be a focal point of this eclectic exhibit. Other highlights will include a self-portrait and a unique spin on a children's book.

Visitors will be treated to a traditional New York Beauty quilt made with non-traditional fabrics of black and brights. Reaching back to her childhood in Westfield where she was born and raised, Ms. Hahn will display her childhood sewing cards, rags from a baby quilt she made at age 12 and her early needlework.

"I'm color driven when I make a more traditional quilt, but I love the challenge of trying to incorporate an item not meant for quilting, such as a dish towel or scarf."

A retired elementary music teacher, Ms. Hahn spent 34 years in the Westfield school system and directs the Children's and Bell Choirs at Cranford Presbyterian Church. She splits her time between Edison, NJ and Brewster, MA, the inspiration for her quilt "Cabins on the Beach." A horseback riding trip to the Triangle X Ranch in Jackson Hole, Wyoming in 2005 inspired her to make her first quilt to commemorate the experience.

A winner of multiple ribbons at Harvest

Quilters shows, where she is Workshop Chair and the Bayberry Quilters of Cape Cod where she serves as Chairperson of the 2017 Challenge quilt, Ms. Hahn expressed that most of all "I cherish all the dear friends I've made through quilting."

Reading, birdwatching, gardening, woodworking and spending time with her extended family enriches her life and fuels her quilting.
