STIRLING FIREFIGHTERS RECEIVE AWARDS

The Stirling Volunteer Fire Company held its annual firefighter appreciation and awards ceremony last Friday, March 17.

The most prestigious award is the distinguished Firefighter of the Year award that was presented to fire company Captain John Whitmore by Fire Chief Kevin Phillips. The chief cited Whitmore's numerous actions that were far above and beyond the call of duty, for his extraordinary dedication to firefighting, and for promoting fire safety in Long Hill Township. As a new captain with many years of fire service in Stirling and Morristown before that, he responded to more than 80% of the over 260 fire alarms in Long Hill Township during 2016 and at many of those alarms he was the Incident Commander.

Before presenting Whitmore with the award, Chief Phillips said, "I am so proud of all the Stirling firefighters and I wish I could give each and every one of you this award for your extraordinary dedication. You certainly are Long Hill Township's heroes every day and every night when an emergency occurs."

Fire Company President Albert Pepe presented the President's Award for outstanding service to Neil Vaish for his dedication to administrative duties, responses to fire alarms, and being elected the vice president of the Fire Co. for 2017.

Years of Service Awards were presented for an astonishing 40 years of service each to Albert Pepe, Anthony Pepe, Kevin Phillips, and Anthony Rito. Together these four firefighters have a combined 160 years of firefighting in the township. A 20 years of service award was presented to Ronni Stein, Stirling's first female firefighter and for 5 years to Nick Giglio, Tom Rozmerski, Randy Wojeck, and Danny Burke.

Members of the Stirling Volunteer Fire Co. have all been unpaid volunteers since the fire company was formed over 100 years ago. Membership is open to residents age 16 or older, both female and male. Training and firefighting gear is provided at no cost to new and seasoned firefighters. Details on membership and fire company events may be seen at their website: www.stirlingfd.com. Stirling's primary response area is Gillette, Homestead Park, Meyersville, and Stirling. They also assist Millington and surrounding towns in their time of need.

The volunteer fire companies in Long Hill Township and the surrounding towns rely heavily on donations from the public to support their hard and often dangerous work. Stirling's President Pepe urges everyone to be generous in

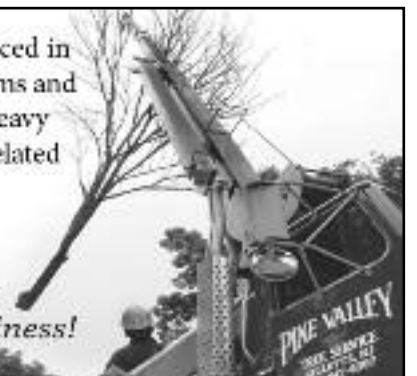

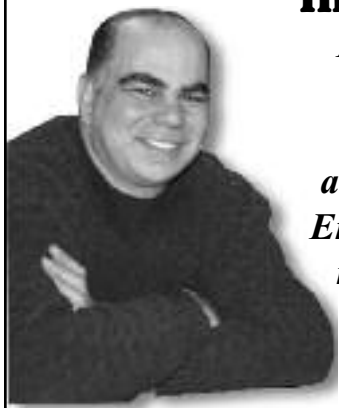

DANIEL LEE NAMED AS A TOP YOUNG SCIENTIST



Watchung Hills Regional High School (WHRHS) Senior Daniel Lee of Watchung has been named one of the top 300 young scientists in the 76th annual Regeneron Science Talent Search (STS).

WHRHS is one of 183 high schools

across the U.S. and one of five comprehensive high schools in New Jersey to have a student selected for this honor. Lee will be awarded \$2,000, and WHRHS will receive \$2,000 to support excellence in science, math, and/or engineering education.

Lee, who has been a center on the WHRHS Varsity Ice Hockey team for four years, is one of the captains of the team. He is also President of the school's Math League and founder of the school's Neuroscience Club.

WHRHS Principal George Alexis congratulated Lee for his achievements. "Daniel

is an exceptional young man," Alexis said. "His commitment to scientific inquiry demonstrates the kind of authentic learning we aspire to as a school community. He brings the same type of commitment and enthusiasm to the ice hockey team and to local environmental initiatives. We're very proud of him."

Lee said he is committed to environmental awareness and clean water issues. "I have been a member of the Borough of Watchung Green Team for the past two years, where I help to organize environmental events for the town, including the weekly Farmers Market and the Annual Green Fair," he said.

Lee said he is now working on possibly having his paper published in a scientific research publication. He said he is leaning toward pursuing studies in material science and applied physics while in college.

Lee thanked his teachers at WHRHS who supported his exploration of scientific research and Physics. "I would like to thank Dr. Sophia Gershman for playing an instrumental role in developing my interest in science and providing invaluable guidance and support during my internship at PPPL," Lee said. "Dr. Gershman was my teacher for the previously-offered Experimental Research and Design course at Watchung Hills, a unique course which allowed students to learn research techniques and explore scientific subjects they were passionate about. I would also like to thank Mr. Brian Brown, my AP Physics teacher, for being an excellent educator and for encouraging me to pursue my interest in Physics."

Lee is the son of Howard and Sophia Lee and brother of Jacqueline Lee.

CHELSEA RESIDENT HELPED GLORIA ESTEFAN GO PLATINUM



With humble beginnings as a wedding band, the Miami Sound Machine had already been well known in the Miami area in the late 70's and early 80's. In 1977 with the addition of a young vocalist named Gloria Maria Fajardo Garcia, later known as Gloria Estefan, they became a phenomenon of the Latin music scene.

But it wasn't until Discos CBS, a subsidiary of CBS International, put out the album Primitive Love on Epic Records in 1985 that the band crossed over into mainstream mega-success. And Jim Hayes, president of Discos CBS, was at the helm.

"Gloria was in my office three or four times a week," he remembers from his apartment at The Chelsea at Warren assisted living residence in Warren, NJ. "She didn't think we were spending enough money on promoting the group, and she was right."

The rest is history, of course, and Jim has the

platinum album to prove it.

"I really wanted that job," he says, recalling the six years he spent in Miami. He had been a veteran of the publishing industry, working for several book companies, one of which was acquired by CBS.

He jumped at the chance to become President and General Manager of Discos CBS, wanting a job with more excitement and a change of scenery. That was in 1985, just as the Miami Sound Machine emerged into the main stream. Hayes was in the driver's seat.

"Gloria and my daughter Carrie became friends," he says.

Today, Hayes, 83, is surrounded by dozens of photo albums, photos of his 6 children, 19 grandchildren and 4 great grandchildren, and technology that keeps him connected via internet, phone and TV.

"This is my life," he says.

PROPERTY OWNERS CAN BUY TREES THROUGH GRANT

Home and or property owners in Long Hill can apply to purchase up to two deciduous shade trees for \$175 through a Challenge Grant offered through the Shade Tree Commission (STC).

The cut off date for applications for the spring planting season is April 15, 2017.

Through this program, property owners can purchase a deciduous shade tree for about half the retail price with Long Hill paying the balance with grant funds, and arranging for installation by the town at their home or property.

The program is designed to be a way for home or business owners in Long Hill to enhance their property individually, and the township as a whole, in a cost effective manner, according to Don Farnell, vice chairman of the STC.

Historically, this program has been used primarily by homeowners to enhance their properties, but this spring the STC would like to encourage all property owners, particularly businesses in the Valley Road corridor, to participate, Farnell said.

There is a limit of two trees per home / property owner on a first come first serve basis. This spring the challenge grant will be limited to 20 trees.

Deciduous tree species available for the Challenge Grant program are determined by commercial availability as determined by the STC.

Property owners interested in participating must complete an application form available at Town Hall or on the Township website at longhillnj.gov and submit a check for \$175 per tree with a maximum two trees per property owner.

Members of the STC will review all applications and contact the property owner to schedule a visit to locate the trees on the property Farnell said. All trees must be located so they can be seen from the street. STC reserves the right to make the final decision on location and arrangement for installation. Once installed, the property owner becomes responsible for the watering and maintenance of the tree as prescribed by the STC.

Application forms can be downloaded from the Township website from either the Shade Tree Commission page or from the forms and permits tab.

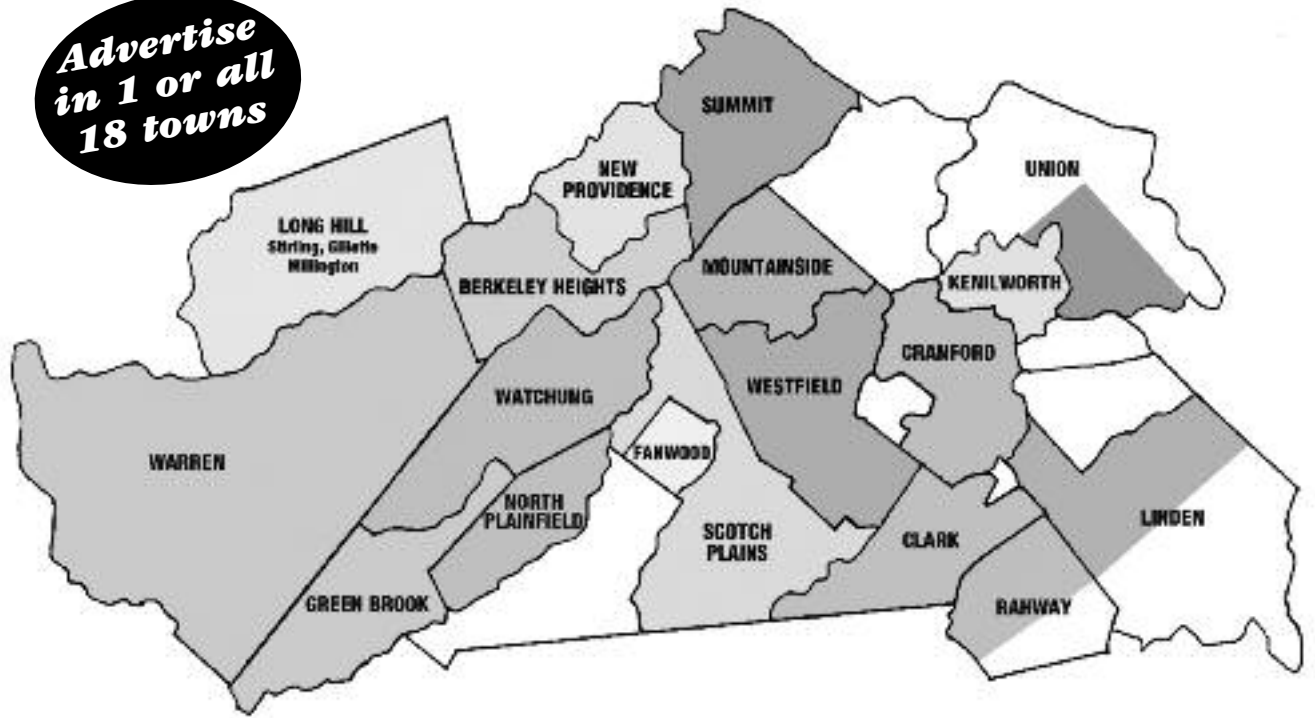
